Ayad to be directly connected to sevashram choraha

Udaipur: UIT's plan to connect Ayad region to Sevashram-Choraha was given a final touch on Monday. Collector and UIT chairman Ashutosh A.T. Pednekar discussed this with UIT officials and has directed them to give an estimate for the new route.

UIT has planned to directly link Ayad region to Sevashram-Choraha. Under this scheme, the building of a bridge till Ayad's end on the Ayad River is proposed. In this way, Ayad region will get directly connected to Sevashram-Choraha. Collector Ashutosh A.T. Pednekar held a detailed discussion of the scheme with the officials on Monday. Giving the route an importance, the collected directed quick action. Three major advantages of the new passage: The new passage proposed by UIT will help Ayad and Hiranmagri in the following ways:



1. New route and bridge will help connect Ayad directly to Sevashram and Hiranmagri region.
2. People going towards Hiranmagri and Sevashram from Ayad won't have to go to ThokarChoraha.
3. This will help curb traffic at ThokarChoraha, which is a traffic-jam prone area.

13 year old generates electricity from cow's urine, will now go to Japan

Udaipur: 13 year old Sakshi Dashora, studying in 8th standard, has generated electricity using cow's urine. A student of Gadvada Vyas Academy, Mavli, Sakshi has made a project titled "Importance of Cow-Breeding in 21st Century" entailing the use of cow dung and cow urine. Under Ministry of Science and Technology's 'Inspire Award', her project will now get an international recognition. This project will be represented in Japan at a seven-day seminar after 2 months. Sakshi will also give a lecture at the event.

For this project, Sakshi was ranked 6th in Udaipur district in August 2014 and later in September, she secured 12th rank at the state level exhibition held at Dungarpur and 2nd at national level. Apart from Sakshi, there are three other students who have been selected to go to Japan. Sakshi informed that cow urine has sodium, potassium, magnesium, sulphur and phosphorous. For her project, she immersed copper and aluminium electrode in one litre urine which was attached to LED watch via wires. The watch started to work as soon as the electricity got generated and was inferred that electricity could be produced according to the quantity of the cow urine. Cow urine helps prevent many ailments including cancer. Application of cow urine mask on body would control body temperature. It can also be used to make incense sticks.

Udaipur railway station to have RO Drinking Water Facilities soon...

Udaipur To provide passengers with purified drinking water, the railway administration is going to put up Reverse Osmosis (RO) plant at Udaipur Railway Station. Railway Board has recently issued an acknowledgement.

The installation of RO plants at railway stations had been restricted by Railway Board. The Railway Board believed that half the amount of water gets wasted while being in the process of treatment under RO. This ban was the main factor why RO plants had not been installed at railway stations until now. But for some time now, passengers' demand for RO drinking water has increased because of the unavailability of portable drinking water and price hike in bottled water at railway stations.

On the basis of these facts, Railway Board has now given its assent to install RO plants. Regional Rail Officer Kamal Sharma and Rail Superintendent S.C. Verma along with other officers marked down sites on the platform to set up RO plants at City Station. In subjection to this, it has been proposed that three RO plants will be installed at platform no. 1 and platform no. 2 platform no. 3 will each have two RO plants.

The installation of RO plant on the newly-built platform no. 2 at RanaPratapnagar Station has also been proposed. For this project, private companies, charitable trusts and people have been requested and several trusts have acquiesced to provide RO plants.

Teachers in Udaipur completed Probation, waiting for confirmation...

Udaipur: Around two thousand teachers recruited after the third grade teacher recruitment exam have not been confirmed yet even after the completion of their probation period and are not being paid the equivalent. In this case, neither the government nor the regional office has any answer. About 40 thousand teachers from the state are being victims of harassment, they keep going around these departments but to no avail. However, if these teachers are not given any

confirmation soon, then the teachers can hold a strike. These teachers were recruited earlier in 2012 whose probation period has been completed in September 2014 (second level) and November 2014 (first level). They are yet being paid the approved salary of the probation period. Therefore, the teachers have approached Union Minister of Panchayati Raj and all officials of Education Department several times but could not find any solution yet.
