Natraj Hotel is a cheap and accessible food haven for good food lovers – local, regional and foreign tourists alike. Natraj Dining Hall, and it would not be wrong call it India's true flavour, is situated at Udiya Pol

Road near Udaipur City Station. On an average, around 2000 people drop by to have their fill of deliciousness at Natraj Dining Hall. The flavour and aroma of the thali and dal baati churmaserved in this lodge promises to never leave

your senses. This lodge earlier worked out of the backyard of Bapu Bazaar, hence, the street came to be known as Natraj Gali. Jitendra, Jayant and Mayank Shrimali, who are brothers, are the directors of the Dining Hall. The USP of

this dining hall is that one of the directors would personally go to your table and address you, whether you order thali, dal baati churma or any of your favourite delicacies. Ravindra Shrimali, who'd been a chairman, started the tradition of

treating their customers with love and humility. Shrimali tells us that in the Rajasthan thali, four kinds of vegetable curries, two kinds of snacks, one sweet, chapati, poori, dal, kadhi, chawal, pickle, chutney, salad, buttermilk, papad and

khichdi are served. The three-storied dining hall is fully air-conditioned. On the ground floor, reception room along with ice-cream parlour is to be launched soon. The Rajasthani thali is provided on the first floor, whereas, on

second floor, along with favourite dishes, Rajasthan flavour dal baati churma and kadhi-chawal is served. The best thing about the dining hall is its low-priced menu which can be easily afforded by common people.

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
