ECO-DESTINATION JHUMAR BAORI (WILDLIFE SANCTUARY JAISAMAND)

The Jaisamand Wildlife Sanctuary is situated 52 Km south of Udaipur, on Udaipur-Banswara road, amidst lush green valleys of Aravallis, which is one of the oldest mountain ranges of the world. The world famous Jaisamand or Jai Samundra lake constitutes an integral part of Sanctuary.

Encompassing a geographical area of 52.34 sq. km, this sanctuary supports a variety of wild animals like, leopard, Striped Hyena, Golden Jackal, Jungle Cat, Rusty-spotted Cat, Indian Fox, common Civet, Grey Mongoose, Ruddy Mongoose, Common Langur, Chinkara, Blue Bull, Wildboar, Hare etc. This sanctuary support 10 species of amphibians, 33 species of reptiles, 227 species of birds and 21 species of mammals. As many as 256 species of plants can be seen in various habitats of sanctuary.

Jhumar Baori :

An ancient step well, full of clean water, amidst a tamarind (Tamarindus indicus) grove is worth seeing. A picturesque wild date palm grove is present in continuation. Rakheswar Mahadeo, a holy place, famous for ancient Lord Shive temple is situated 500 m away from the baori.

Jeepable path to Jhumar Baori passes through thick forests the sanctuary. Driving between Palodara gate- Jhumar Baori-Dhimra Bag gives a feeling the virgin forest. The forest comprises Dhok (Anogeissus pendula), Ghat Ber (Ziziphus xylopyrus), Khair (Acacia catechu), Kumtha (Acacia senegal) etc. in abundance.

A day camping site has been developed at Jhumar Baori. Visitors can enjoy with their families in thatched Jhompas. Day meeting can be held there. A thatched meeting space is available here which can house 50 persons. Various adventurous game facilities are also available at Jhumar Baori day camping site.

PEELADAR BIRDING AREA :

Peeladar dam is a beautiful perennial water body toward North-western part of the sanctuary. This is a bird paradise also. A beautiful hide has been constructed for birding, Bird lovers can enjoy their birding passing at Peeladar dam.

BOARDING AND LODGING :

A four-roomed forest rest house is there on the southern end of the dam near jaisamand bus stand. Besides this, four tents are available for stay at Dhimra bag. Boarding and loading facilities are available here for the visitors. Self help groups provide snacks and foot at jhumar Baori, Dhimra bagt and Jaisamand Rest House on reasonable price. Boating facility is available at Jaisamand dam.
