Two Cadaveric Kidney Transplants Successfully done At Shalby Hospitals

Udaipur: Shalby Hospitals, Ahmedabad, a multi-speciality healthcare facility, has added another feather to its cap, successfully conducting two cadaveric transplants in June benefiting four patients consequentially.

Cadaveric transplants refer to organs transplanted from the deceased or an unrelated donor. The operation was carried out by Dr. Manoi Gumber and Dr. Jigar Shrimali from the nephrology team of the hospital and Dr. Dipak Joshi, Dr. Kartik Shah, Dr. Amit Trivedi and Dr. C.P.Garg from the urology division.

Sushila Devi Shah, the first of the donors, aged 55 and a diabetic, was admitted to Shalby on June 14, 2015 suffering from a case of brain hem-

dead after neurosurgery was initiated at the hospital

The pious Sushila Devi meanwhile, was popular for her penchant to lend out a helping hand to those in need and donated quite regularly to Narayan SewaSanstha, AndhjanMandal and old age homes.

It was to lend credence and support her social efforts that her family members decided to donate her organs. Following this decision, both her kidneys, eyes and liver were pledged and contributed that went on to save the lives of various patients, a matter of pride for her A similar case came along few

days later on June 24 this year when Ketalben Kaushal Shah, 41, from a humble background in Ahmedabad and a worker for five years at the urban health centre of the municipal corporation of Memnagar area, got orrhaged. She was declared brain herself admitted to Shalby with a sim-

ilar case of vein burst. It was her husband and son's decision to donate both the eyes, kidney and liver after she too was declared brain dead.

"The cases were critical. We got the best doctors to spearhead their treatment. While declaring a patient brain dead is always a sensitive affair mired in emotions on the family front, it was a brave decision taken by the family members to contribute organs for the benefit and survival of the others who suffer and have a ray of hope to live another day," said Dr. Manoj Gumber, from the nephrology team of Shalby Hospitals.
