

CM in Delhi to promote investment in Rajasthan

"Rajasthan recognizes the role industry plays in fostering all-round development – it creates jobs and generates revenue to enable social sector spends," Smt. Vasundhara Raje, Chief Minister of Rajasthan, said here today.

The Chief Minister was addressing an investor meet organized by the Government of Rajasthan in association with the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII). "The core idea is to create an economy that works for everyone, in which every citizen has the chance to realize their dreams. We must recognise we do not live in an economy, but in a society. We must promote economic development in a manner that equal benefits accrue to investors as well as to our citizens," she added.

Asserting that industrial resurgence was not an end itself, the Chief Minister revealed that the theme of the Partner Summit was 'Delivering Dreams, Sharing Prosperity'. The theme highlighted the fact that the overall focus of the State government was on last-mile delivery and prosperity for all.

During the event, 12 MoUs were signed between private companies and the government to set up industrial units in the state involving a



total investment of Rs. 2530 crore. on the behalf of Rajasthan Govt. the MOU were Signed by Commissioner, Industries Shri Abhay Kumar. The proposed industrial units are expected to generate approximately 8000 jobs and several thousand more indirect employment opportunities. The Delhi roadshow is a part of a series of events being held across India and abroad to promote investment opportunities in Rajasthan ahead of the global Resurgent Rajasthan Partnership Summit, slated to be held in Jaipur on November 19 and 20, 2015. Earlier roadshows in Japan, Germany, Mumbai, Pune, Kolkata,

Indore, Bengaluru, Chennai, Hyderabad and Ludhiana have been huge successes, and have attracted the interest of a large cross-section of investors.

Industries Minister, Shri Gajendra Singh Khimsar, stated, "Rajasthan provides a great opportunity to investors from all parts of India and overseas to expand their business, reliably source material and establish new manufacturing capacities. the Intercoiffure Globe Educator Award 2010 apart from several accolades in the past. He is a regular presenter at the most prestigious global hairdressing events. He trained Pradeep in Long Hair Styling.

ment. Through international cooperation and development between industry, government, organisations, and institutions, it promotes the benefits of and need for skilled professionals through grass-roots community projects, skill competitions, and knowledge exchange.

Bravehearts in the making of Loco-Pilots

Udaipur : Life isn't easy for a Loco-pilot at all. 8-10 hours of driving almost standing, exposed to harsh weather conditions, odd duty hours and the worse-Engines not even having a toilet. A job considered toughest even for men, could be unimaginable for women. In Indian context, imagine a woman who is away from home for about a full day, and comes back quite tired. She'd have least quality time with her kids, and managing a family would be hard indeed.

However, challenges comes as an adventure for these bravehearts who have stepped into the process of making a loco-pilot. Seema Prajapati, Tanu Priya Shukla, Pooja Kumari from Jhansi, Madhya Pradesh and Sunita Choudhary from Kota are among a batch of 157 trainees from the North Western Railway Zone who are undergoing a 4-week rigorous training schedule for loco-pilots at the Udaipur Zonal Railway Training School. The training will last on September 4. These girls faced impediments from relatives and neighbours who illustrated reasons and difficulties before their family members on why they should not send their daughters to become a loco-pilot, but luckily, their parents were supportive who believed in their daughters.

"We know well that apart from the technical abilities to drive a train, immense physical and mental strength is required to become a good loco-pilot and we are confident that we would become one some day" said Seema Prajapati, a polytechnic engineer hailing from a small village Lohaghar in Jhansi district. No one from her family had ever been in Railways and so when she got through the Railway

Recruitment Board's exam for Loco pilots, relatives had advised against a career in Railways. "Along with the great skill that is needed to operate the control panel of an Engine, enormous levels of patience is also required. It will require grit, courage and years of patience after we start off as an Assistant LP to work in a goods train first, then passenger and finally pilot an Express train which is the ultimate dream for a driver" said Sunita Choudhary, who is a B.Tech in Electronics. "Our Instructors told us the very first day- forget the coolers and heaters, if you want to run long" said Tanu Priya whose mother is a school teacher and father runs an electronic shop in Jhansi.

"Most of the Goods lines run between the mining areas and industries to transport the minerals. These lines run through areas that are not inhabited by human population and pass through several hills and tunnels and we have to be prepared to work in such conditions" she added. "Alertness is the thumb rule for loco-pilots. Standing is an unsaid rule for drivers as sitting might make the pilot drowsy which will put thousands of lives in peril. A pilot can never get off an engine in any case, except when the track is damaged either by natural calamities like landslides" said Pooja Kumari, an ITI diploma holder in Electronics. But we feel that alertness comes as a natural instinct for the fairer sex since mothers are more cautious and vigilant than fathers" she added. In the month long training these women pilots would learn about engine components, transportation, signalling, braking-Air Braking, troubleshooting, identifying and rectifying faults.
