## Govt announces to implement OROP

Giving relief to lakhs of ex-servicemen, Modi Government has announced the implementation of 'one rank one pension' for the armed forces.

It will be implemented from the first of July, 2014 with the base year as 2013. Defence Minister Manohar Parrikar announced the one rank, one pension scheme during a press conference today.

The long wait for One Rank One Pension finally comes to an end. In a major relief to ex-servicemen, government has announced One rank one Pension.

--Despite its huge financial implications of about Rs.10,000 crore, Government went ahead with OROP

--Pension will be re-fixed every five years.

--Personnel who voluntarily retired will not be covered by OROP.

--The benefit of OROP will be given from 1 July 2014.

--Arrears will be paid in four half-yearly installments.

--However, War widows will get full arrears in one installment.

Government estimates that Rs 10000-12000 crore will be the cost of OROP arrears. However, The UPA Government announced the implementation of OROP with the budgetary allocation of a mere 500 crore rupees but did not announce a deadline for implementing it.

--One rank one pension means that all armed forces personnel who retire at the same rank after the same length of service will draw the same amount of pension irrespective of the date of retirement.

The demand of the veterans that is over 4 decades old and was continuously neglected by successive governments is finally implemented giving a sigh of relief and a smile to millions of brave soldiers.

Urban Development Minister Venkaiah Naidu has welcomed the One Rank One Pension and said now this issue has been resolved completely and Government has fulfilled its promise.

He further said if the soldiers and ex-servicemen had any point of disagreement and dissatisfaction, they should sit with Government and talk it out.

Minister of state for Information & Broadcasting Col Rajyavardhan Rathore said only Prime Minister Modi and this government could fulfill the OROP promise because they understood the issue completely.

Senior Congress leader and former Defence Minister A K Antony termed the OROP announcement by the Government as totally disappointing.

## Rajasthan's smallest : 607 gms baby survives despite all odds in Jivanta Udaipur



**Udaipur :** For geeta and her husband rajesh lohar it's the greatest gift from god to see their three month old survives the odds and come home from the neonatal icu at jivanta children's hospital, udaipur.

Born to a couple married for 17 years. Her pregnancy was carried upto 27 weeks when her blood pressure was uncontrollable and the ultrasonography revealed fetoplacental insufficiency because the blood flow to the babies was decreasing, she was taken up for emergency caesarean section.

Baby gita twin girls were born premature just at 27 weeks of pregnancy (normal pregnancy duration 40 weeks) and weighing just 607 grams and 1275gms at birth 11th June. These twin girls were very precious and the only hope for the family. The baby required artificial breathing support to regularized here breathing and then she was quickly transferred to jivanta neonatal icu.

To salvage an infant of this size was challenging. There is no reported survival of a baby weighing this small in rajasthan. Last reported smallest survival was a baby weighing 682 grams.

Babies born this small have extremely poor function of all body organs which include lungs, heart, brain kidney, intestine, skin, adrenals etc. And all of them need support for survival of the baby. This is where a skilled and dedicated neonatologist and nicu nursing staff is required to identify and prevent or correct these problems, as the margin of error in this tiny babies is close to none. Problems related to any one system can singularly kill the baby and is the commonest outcome in these cases. The babies that young have only 20% - 30% chance to survival and only 5-10% survive without brain damage. We call her a 'miracle baby'.

The baby was handled and looked after in the jivanta children's hospital-neonatal icu with precise care under dr. Sunil janged (neonatologist), dr. Mani bhatnagar and trained nursing team. She was struggling to breathe, so was immediately put on advanced respiratory support (ventilator) and given medicines to expand her tiny, immature lungs. She cannot be fed adequately due to immaturity of gut. We had to start the baby on total parenteral nutrition, which basically means giving all the essential nutrients such as amino acids, lipids, carbohydrates, minerals, multivitamins and trace elements directly into blood circulation.

This procedure required special expertise and facilities. The baby also required special venous access point

as their veins do not tolerate these medicines. Such baby quickly loses all body water through their fragile parchment like skin by evaporation or they may drain all body water through their immature kidneys. Initial days were difficult as her birth weight dropped down to 500 grams. Gradually she started digesting few drops of milk these are special problems one has to anticipate and be prepared when you are managing a baby. This small baby required respiratory support on and off for a period of about 1 month. She was able to start drinking from spoon only after about 10 weeks of birth.

In all, she was in the nicu for almost 85 days and today she is being discharged when discharged, here weight was close to 1750 grams. Honestly i was walking on ice throughout but she is a fighter and is improving brilliantly by far the progress and clinical course in the nicu was very satisfactory for a baby of her weight and gestational age. Her brain is structurally normal and eyes are also developing normal.

We are grateful to geeta and her family and we appreciate them for setting a new example to the community. Rajasthan where the girls still considered a burden, are thrown in the trash immediately after birth or are left in the orphanage, geeta couple treated their girls who had little chance of survival and today both girl twins are healthy.

It is the latest technology, high end equipments and expertise of our nicu team, which has given the phenomenal result and that jivanta is now routinely having a more than 99% survival of extremely low birth babies' said dr. Sunil janged, chief neonatologist at jivanta children's hospital.
