UN Automobiles' property seized

Udaipur : After UN Automobiles Udaipur, Bank Of Baroda is now set to seize the property of Jaipur, Sumerpur'sPali. Recovery chief manager of Bank of Baroda, Jaipur, SK Gupta, said that being unable to repay the loan instalment, the bank has declared this group as defaulter. Bank Recovery Department has sought approval from the local administration of Jaipur and Pali. Once approved, the bank will seize property on Monday. Earlier Thursday, the Bank seized UN's Udaipur Goverdhan Vilas showroom service center in Maddi. It was informed that the UN automobile in 2010,had taken a loan of Rs 37 crore from Bank of Baroda Bapu Bazar branch, which has now become 75 crore including interest. After this, UN has not repaid the bank's loan due to which the account got NPA in 2012. The bank sent a notice to the UN, which was the case at the UN automobiles management bank. The case was decided by the Court in 2015. The management then decided to siege the property.

UCCI for a smart chamber

Udaipur : Former presidents and officials of the Udaipur Chamber of Commerce and Industry met and discussed key points in order to make the Udaipur a smart city. The attendees talked on certain points about the smart city campaign and discussed on things that should be there for a smart industrial association. PM to leave for climate summit on 29 Nov

French capital Paris has been placed under heavy security blanket for Global Climate Change Conference, beginning tomorrow. Prime Minister Narendra Modi will be leaving New Delhi today for the French capital to attend the conference. Over one lakh police and para-military personnel have been deployed to provide fool-proof security.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi would be addressing world leaders at the Paris conference on Monday. India would be keenly watched for the stand it takes, at the critically important world conference on climate change. All eyes will be on Prime Minister Narendra Modi, when he speaks at the Paris Conference on Climate Change on Monday.

Especially the developing nations as they would be looking upon him to champion their interests in winning



funds and and transfer of green technology from the comity of developed nations to mitigate the worst effects of

climate change.

The developed nations would also be watching India keenly for the posi-

tion it takes for the world to arrive at a workable and sustainable solution. India has giving enough indications that it favours an outcome that levies equitable responsibility. When Prime Minister Modi had met U.S. President Barack Obama, French President and UK Prime Minister in September on the sidelines of the UN General Assembly in New York, he called for a agenda from talks in Paris that helps developing countries with access to finance and technology. After meeting Obama he had said the American president shared with him an uncompromising commitment to fighting climate change without hurting development. "We look forward to comprehensive and concrete outcome in Paris with a positive agenda on combating climate change which also focuses on

access to finance and technology for the developing world, especially the poor countries and small island states."

Infact the vexed issue of climate change targets had dominated the hour-long conversation the PM had held with the US president. Prime Minister had at that time called for the 'climate of negativism' surrounding climate change negotiations to end and change the debate into a positive format. And the US president sought to encourage that. The Prime Minister had taken a similar position during his meetings with British Prime Minister David Cameron and French president François Hollande. It now remains to be seen when the world leaders meet in Paris on Monday would they be able to stitched together an agreement that is expectable to all.

Aravali Critical Care Hospital to save Lives more adequately

Udaipur : Aravali Hospital Private Limited launched first of its kind, highly equipped, Trauma Emergency and Critical Care Hospital loaded with international standard facilities and best critical care expert doctors. Dr Anand Gupta, director of Aravali Hospital informed that Aravali Trauma Center and Aravali Critical Care launched on Sunday. The hospital has 21 Beds ICU ward for responding critical patients of heart attack, severe injury and paralysis.

The emergency service will be provided 24 hrs by well known doctors of Ahmadabad including Dr M Farukh Memon, Dr Jigar Mehta, Dr Sandeep Vaghela, Dr Saumil Singhvi and their teams. All over there will be 8 staff from Ahmadabad and 12 nursing staff from Udaipur, all well trained by team of crit-

ical care from Ahmadabad specialist in tackling emergency situations.

There will be 2 doctors available all 24 hours in the hospital. Out of 21 beds, 13 will be ICU and 8 beds will be at step-down to shift the out of danger patient from ICU to step down. Moreover after bringing the patient to out-of-danger, the decision of further treatment will be left on patient himself and there will be no pressurizing from doctors. Dr Farukh Memon and Dr Jigar Mehta are managing the critical care unit of many hospitals of Ahmadabad like Rajasthan Hospital, Jeevraj Mehta Cardiac ICU, Shifa Multi-specialty ICU, Siddhi Vinayak, GCS Medical College and Ashirwad Hospital. Both of them have very significant role in developing the concept of critical care in Gujarat.
