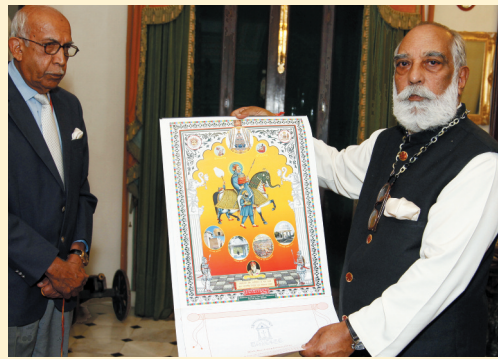

Action taken in 739 cases to prevent Illegal gravel mining!!

State campaign is being operated since 27th October to prevent illegal gravel mining and issues. Action was taken in 739 cases from 27th October to 9th December, in this joint campaign of Revenue, Mines, Forest and Transportation departments to prevent illegal gravel mining. According to the director of Mines and geology Department, Udaipur Shri DS Maru, 730 vehicles, 177 machines and tools were seized and 48 FIRs were registered and action was taken in 59 cases of land rights in Neem ka Thana area and 35 illegal gravel plots were destroyed. He told that in this period amount of recovery of overload 8,00,300 rupees, mineral prices (royalty tenfold) and compound fees as 1,73,39,959 rupees were recovered and overall sum of 1,81,40,259 rupees were recovered.

The health insurance scheme was launched in the presence of BJP national president Amit Shah who was chief guest at the function held in Janpath to mark two years anniversary of the state government. "Our mission was to bring back Swabhiman of Rajasthan - to put state back on its feet and I am happy with how much we have progressed so far" she said while taking a dig at the previous government. "We clearly had a mess in our hands but we found balance among aspirations of the people, short resources and the many, many elections".

She said the huge mandate given by the people kept the government humble and strengthened determination to take out Rajasthan from the Bimaru tag. Raje said there are demands (from opposition parties) about two years' achievements of the state government but they have not given their records for last seven years.

of her government, Raje said 290 places in the state have been WiFi enabled, Nayay Apke Dwar reduced pending cases, Apka Jila Apki Sarkar helped in solving problems of districts. She said through Resurgent Rajasthan it has been proved that a number of companies are interested in investing in the state.

She said the Congress had left the state in deep debt which her government was trying to come out of. About comparison of Rajasthan government with other BJP ruled states, Raje said the comparison with MP and Chhattisgarh is not tenable as the BJP has been ruling there for last 15 years.

Raje also announced implementation of Bhamashah Employment Generation Scheme from Sunday. The scheme is aimed at providing easy loans

to unemployed people registered with employment offices.
