He does not hold any government portfolio. He thus is free and is keeping vigil on all department but majority he handles all the politics and keeps rest of his ministers insulated from external allegations and heats. At times Arvind if found targeting Modi and BJP and on the other occasions, media helps comparing the two. 

Jha would also chair the opening of Film Market and also production meet on January 3rd while Crowd Funding would be discussed on January 4th and Writers' Meet would be held on January 5th. All these events would be held at the Golecha Cinema Hall.

Special screenings of films would be held on January 5th at The Golecha for college students and at The Pink City Press Club for school students.

The screening of films and other events of the Festival like workshops and semi-

nars would be held at The Golecha, located at the Chaura Raasta, Manipal University at the Ajmer Road, Press Club at the Narayan Singh Circle and the Rajasthan Praudh Shikshan Samiti at Jhalana Institutional Area.

Rajasthan would find a special place in the Festival this time as the films connected with Rajasthan would be screened on the opening and the closing ceremonies. There has been increased representation of films from Asian countries this time. There are representation of Pakistan, Afghanistan, UAE, Iran besides European countries and India.

subjects concerning women to get screening in the Festival. The segment of Horror films would be the added attraction of the festival. A total of 35 feature films, 17 documentary feature films, 58 short films, 17 documentary short films and 15 short animation films will be screened.

The films, to be screened in competitive and other sections, have been selected from the entries of 2176 films received from 100 countries. It would be for the first time in any film festival anywhere in the world that as many as 17 documentary feature films would be screened in addition to three Oscar nominated films and 11 debut films of directors.

In the non competitive section MSG-2 of Gurmeet Ram Rihm Singh, LOVE ON THE RUN from US, YAARON SAMJHA KARO of Aditya Chokse, DEFINITION OF FEAR, a horror film from Hollywood and PARINITI of Prakash Jha.

Hanu Roj said Film Market would be inaugurated with the screening of Pavan Kaul's film THE ANSWER on January 3 at 1:15 PM at the Golcha Cinema. Next day (January 4) special workshops and seminars would be held on Crowd Funding, Film Funding, and Digital Film Distribution.
