

Teachers Awaken, Addiction an "Ice Berg"

Like an ice in the sea a very small part of that is visible on the surface of the sea water which is known as "Ice Berg "but a major part of this ice lies hidden under the sea water Similarly the addiction which is spreading in the society is also visible as an Ice berg. This is not visible because still it is a social stigma which prevents its spread in the society. We do not know extant of the enormousity of the addiction.

This was told by the Pani Parvayaran Puruskar Award 2015 winner & the person who is engaged in the awareness of De-Addiction & Roof Top Rain water harvesting from last two decades Dr.P.C.Jain & Medical & Social Practitoner of Udaipur among the Refresher course of Mathematics Teachers which is Continuing in the Govt.Guru Govind Singh Sr.sec School near Bhupal Stadium, Udaipur He appealed the teachers to be the "Role Models" for the students by not using any kind of addictive substance & be away from the Substance

Citing the reasons for the spreading of Addiction he told about 12 "F" he framed like Family, Friends, Fashion, Freedom, Free Availability of the substance to be Abused.

As how to identify the addictive students, he gave some hints for that like to observed among them as Frequent change of the friends, change in the behavior, Untidy dressing, uncombed hair, failing in the course in which he/she was

perfect leads to suspicion for substance abuse(Addiction)

Dr jain was about worried the increase abuse of Tobacco. Gutkha, Supari in the lower classes in the schools. He advised the teachers to perform "Four finger Test" to identify these cases.

He narrated some of the real stories which shows the extant of the spread among the students & the society. Talking about his observation during his U.S.A. &comparison he said that 50% of the mouth cancer is common in our country because of smokeless tobacco & Gutkha.

How the addiction is more harmful for the women as compared the men he told that because of the difference in the body structure & Hormones any kind of substance abuse is more harmful for them. Also they have to give child birth & during the period of pregnancy this addiction badly affects the formation of the body structure of the child leading many to many fetal abnormalities.

How to how de addict he advised to talk to such student in privacy & with sympathy & assist him to get rid of this addiction. In the end of his 281 th presentation one De addiction(Nasha Geet) poem was recited with dancing giving the advise to all to leave all kind of addiction. (Nasha ne chodo rae) the principal Mr. Bheru lal teli thanked Dr P.C. iain & Mr Mohmmed Igubal Sheikh (Trainning Incharge) Introdued him.
