# Actor Nawazuddin Siddiqui booked for 'molesting' woman

**Mumbai:**

Actor Nawazuddin Siddiqui has been booked by the Versova police after a 24-year-old girl complained he molested her during an argument over parking at the apartment complex they both reside in on Sunday after noon. The actor was not arrested till late at night. Despite repeated attempts, the actor could not be reached for a comment, but his manager, Anup Pandey, denied the charge.

"It is a false case. The case has been registered without

investigation. It is a society issue which has been going on for a long time," Pandey told PTI. "There was an argument, but no hatha pai (exchange of physical blows) as claimed in the complaint. We will take the matters up."

Arun Chavan, assistant commissioner of police, said, "We registered a case against Siddiqui based on the complainant's version. As of now we have not arrested any person, and are in the process of verifying the facts."

According to the com-



plainant, who is the granddaughter of the society's chairman, she was sitting in the society office at around 1.30pm when a person came and tried to park his motorcycle within the society. Siddiqui's bodyguards who were standing at the spot asked the person not to park his motorcycle there.

The complainant said that when she heard the commotion, she came out of the office and started clicking photographs on her mobile phone. The motorcyclist left the society, and at the same time

Siddiqui came down to the area and asked the complainant not to click photographs and this led to an altercation.

The complainant alleged that when she refused, Siddiqui pushed her following which she called the police. In her complaint, the woman also pointed out that Siddiqui had refused to accept a notice sent earlier by the society's chairman and secretary to members over complaints related to parking space. The notice was sent to Siddiqui over him using additional parking space.

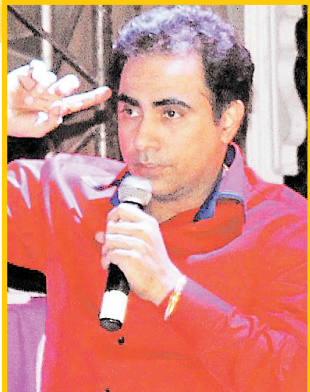
# Goal Setting Taps Subconscious Mind Power to Achieve Grand Success: Dr Arvinder Singh

# Union Minister Dattatreya booked for abetting Dalit student's suicide

**Hyderabad :** The police in Hyderabad on Monday booked Union Minister Bandaru Dattatreya and three others for abetment of suicide and also for violations of the SC/ST Atrocities Act following the suicide of a Dalit research scholar of the University of Hyderabad. niversity Vice-Chancellor Appa Rao and Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad (VP) leaders Sushil Kumar and Vishnu have also been booked. The cases under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code and also the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (prevention of atrocities) Act were filed in Gachibowli police station under Cyberabad police commissionerate limits.

Gachibowli inspector J. Ramesh Kumar told IANS that the cases were booked on a complaint by Prashant, a student. "An investigating officer will conduct

the investigations," the officer said when asked what action would be taken. The complainant blamed Dattatreya for the suicide as he had written a letter to union Minister for Human Resource Development Smriti Irani, which led to suspension of Dalit students. Dattatreya, who is union minister of state for labour (Independent Charge), had demanded action against "anti-national" and "anti-social" elements on the campus. Rohith Vemula, a second-year research scholar of science, technology and society studies department, was found hanging from the ceiling of a room in New Research Scholars' hostel on Sunday night. He was one of the five Dalit students suspended and expelled from the hostel. They were staging protest on the campus for the past 15 days. Student groups alleged Rohith was in depression

due the social boycott which he and other students were subjected to. The police officer said they registered a case under Section 174 of the Criminal Procedure Code with regard to the student's suicide. "We will take further action after receiving post-mortem examination report," the inspector said.
