

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Glimpses of RDay in Udaipur

Cobalt Therapy Machine MB

Udaipur : The cancer department of MB hospital will be equipped with cobalt therapy machine. The budget finalization committee has sanctioned a sum of four crores of rupees. Besides this, committee has also approved budget for expansion of hospitals affiliated to RNT medical college. with this budget approval, the 20 years old cobalt therapy machine will be replaced with the new one. As per sources, one year was left before the radiation source of the old machine would be expired. In such a scenario, the replacement is good and proactive step. Principal Dr. DP Singh informed that the new machine will provide radiation in just one and half minutes as compared to 5-6 minutes from the old machine. Dr. Singh apprised that committee has also approved 1.7 crores of rupees for other equipments. The budget also has provision to continue the construction work.

Tourism gets a boost in Udaipur

Udaipur : State home minister Gulab Chand Kataria has announced to give 40 crores of rupees for the development of tourist spots around the city. the forest department will get 10 crores of rupees every year. Awake Brain Tumour surgery at Mewar Hospital

Udaipur : Doctors at Mewar Multispecialty Hospital, Udaipur has successfully operated a brain tumour, patient being awake through out the procedure. Bhillwara resident 50-year-old Mr. Kishan Das Vishnav was operated successfully for Brain Tumour surgery while he was talking and listening bhajan simultaneously. The surgery was performed on 19 January 2016 by Neurosurgeon Dr. Ajit Singh and his team including Dr. Vijay Shekhawat (Anaesthesist). During the press conference, Dr Singh mentioned that most of the brain tumour surgeries are done under anaesthesia. However, when the patient is unconscious, there is a risk of partial removal of tumour and patient has over 50% risk of paralysis. During the surgery that lasted 2 hours, the patient was awake and reacting to Doctor's command. Post surgery, patient was com-



pletely fit and ready to be discharge today. Dr Manish Chhparwal, founder of Mewar Group of Hospitals, emphasized that this kind of surgery is rare and helps reduce the risk of paralysis in patients post such complex surgery. Mewar Group of Hospital is chain of 20 hospitals and is performing typical brain surgeries, knee and hip replacement surgeries, spine and Arthroscopy surgeries for over a decade.
