Lokanuranjan Mela to be held on 21st-22nd February



Udaipur : Lokanuranjan Mela will be held on 21st and 22nd February on the foundation of internationally acclaimed folk arts institution Bhartiya Lok Kala Mandal, Udaipur. Deputy Director of the institution Goverdhan Samar and Honorary Secretary Tahseen Riaz said that on the occasion of the 65th founding anniversary of the institution, it has been decided that the Lokanuranjan Mela will be organized from February 21 to 22. The institution use to organize Lokanuranjan Mela many years ago. On this occasion, folk artists from the region and other states are invited to perform in front of the general on a stage so that such form of arts and artists are encouraged. To establish this tradition, the management has decided that the institution should start reintroducing Lokanuranjan to the people. For this event, about 125 folk artists from Rajasthan, Gujarat and Goa have been invited, who will be performing on institution's stage in front of the general public.

Doctors leave for Barabanki for 33rd Surgery camp



Udaipur : It will be 33rd free medical camp in Barabanki and as usual, doctors have left for their services to mankind. A team of five doctors left for Baranki from BN College of Udaipur on February 5 with a mission to continue the legacy of service selflessly to the needy ones. Women from tribal areas are moving from thumb to pens

Udaipur : If we want to proceed, take full advantage of the primary features and schemes run by the government, we need to study. Education not only provides jobs, but also provides an understanding of right and wrong. Education is the key to all locks and problems, so we need to get educated and send our children to school regularly. This idea was expressed by Sarada panchayat committee chief Mohan Lal Kharadi as a chief guest at Tara Akshar Plus, a women's literacy program organized by Gayatri Sewa Sansthan at Village Padra.

Shailendra Pandya, Joint Director, Gayatri Sewa Sansthan, said while presiding

the program, that under the Tara Akshar, with the help of Delhi's Development Alternative Institute a course of 56 days will be given to women at a time convenient to them which will be free of cost, due to which the illiterate women of the tribal region have not only learnt to sign but also read a newspaper, to perform basic arithmetic and write the names of family members. It has also helped women to gain confidence.

The special guest of the program, UNICEF Rajasthan's consultant Ravi Dayal congratulated the first batch of 72 women educated under the project and appealed to other women to come regularly to the centre.

Patent Ductus Arteriosus (PDA) Closure

Udaipur : Cardiology team of geetanjali Hospital Dr Ramesh Patel, Dr CP purohit and Dr Harish Sanadhya operated on Congenital Heart defect that is PDA by percutaneous means.

PDA is a congenital defect between Aorta (Carrying Oxygenated blood) and Pulmonary artery (carrying deoxygenated blood) which can lead to recurrent pneumonia, shortness of breath, Heart Failure and if not treated timely will lead to development of blueness of body, infection and later on Death.

It can be treated with surgical means where chest cavity is opened and percutaneous method wherein suitable device is placed at PDA site. This case of 10 year old child meera from pratapgarh admitted with shortness of breath found to have 6 mm large PDA on echocardiography. She was planned for device closure of PDA. It took one hour to team to complete the procedure successfully.

Innovative Startups Receive Prize and Incubation Support at Udaipur Startup Fest

Udaipur : Udaipur is an ideal destination for developing a vibrant and strong Startup ecosystem since it has an IIM and five private universities. The platform provided during the fest will be of immense use to the young budding entrepreneurs and startups, said, Ms Venu Gupta. She was speaking at the inaugural session of the one-day Udaipur Startup Fest held at Chamber Bhawan of Udaipur Chamber of Commerce and Industry (UCCI) on 6th.

Organised by Rajasthan State Industrial Development and Investment Corporation (RIICO) along with Rajasthan's leading incubation centre, Startup Oasis, the Udaipur Startup Fest was inaugurated in the Lake City on Saturday.

Addressing the inaugural session, Principal Secretary Industries further said: "Rajasthan has always had a strong entrepreneurial talent. Since the signing of an MoU between RIICO and CII initiatives IIM-Ahmedabad in June, 2013 the start-up ecosystem in the State has gained momentum over the last two years. Start-up Oasis, the Incubation Centre of RIICO at Jaipur has trained, through their workshops, more than 1000 students, supported more than 100 start-ups and incubated 58 start-ups."



Highlighting the Rajasthan State Startups Policy 2015, she further said, "The Policy which was announced in October last year just before the Resurgent Rajasthan Partnership Summit is a realistic Policy that will lay down a roadmap for next 5 years. Through the policy we are actively engaged in expanding the Startup ecosystem in areas beyond Jaipur", she said.

She further informed that in the Policy there was a provision for organizing one major national level startup festival like Startup Fest-2015 held in Jaipur last year. It would also organize two small Startup Fests. It is in line with this provision that such Startup

Fests will be organized at regular intervals in different regions of the state to inculcate the habit of innovation culture and commercialization thereby creating a dynamic environment.

Earlier, the Chief General Manager, RIICO, Mr Anil Sharma gave the welcome address and the Chief Operating Officer at Startup Oasis, Mr Chintan Bakshi concluded the inaugural session by giving a presentation on the Rajasthan Startup ecosystem.

Other prominent speakers at the inaugural ceremony included, Founder and CEO of BOOND, Mr Rustam Sengupta; Co-founder and CEO of Thrillophilia.com, Ms Chitra Daga who shared their experiences and journey

of growth of their Startups.

The inaugural session was followed by an interesting session on Udaipur Startup Ecosystem wherein the speakers threw light on the growing Startup ecosystem of the region.

The event also witnessed 'Startup Expo' where over 22 Rajasthan-based Startups showcased their services and products to the investors and mentors who attended the fest. The one-day Udaipur Startup Fest came to an end on Saturday with the prizes being given for the Tech4Raj, Rajasthan's largest social innovation and entrepreneurship scouting program. The prizes were given away by Chief General Manager, Mr Anil Sharma, COO, Startup Oasis, Mr Chintan Bakshi and Mr Anoop Mathur, DGM, RIICO.

It may be recalled that Tech4Raj, the annual Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship program organised by Startup Oasis was launched on January 6th, 2016. Over 200 applications from across the country were received for the programme. Top 15 teams selected were taken through a mentoring program in collaboration with Pacific University, Udaipur. These teams presented their final pitches to a team of mentors on February 5 in the Bootcamp organized as a part of the fest. The prizes were given under

two different categories - Innovation and Enterprise - today.

Under the Innovation category, the first prize of Rs. 30,000 was won by Khushi Baby who presented their start-up idea on wearable NFC (Near Field Communication) devices for infants which can track their vaccination record. The second prize of Rs 20,000 went to 'Alligator Technologies' who presented their pitch on Smart Stethoscope - a wireless stethoscope through which doctors can diagnose a patient in remote area.

While under the Enterprise category, the first prize of Rs 30,000 was won by 'Rural Ally' who presented their pitch on rural e-commerce method trying to develop a rural supply chain system by providing lucrative deals. The second prize of Rs 20,000 was won by 'On the Farm' who presented their idea of developing an app for virtual farming which is linked to real farm products.

Apart from the prize money the winners will also get co-working space from Startup Oasis, Jaipur for 3 months and may get financial support from the Rajasthan Government under the Rajasthan Startup Policy if they fulfill all the required criteria.
