Kill the Monster While it's Little

Udaipur : Dr Arvinder Singh, CEO and CMD of Arth Diagnostics shared his experiences and research in the National alliance meet organised by Japanese company 'Horiba' at Hyderabad. Early diagnosis is the key for proper treatment and management of the patients. There is a common saying that kill the monster while it's little.
