



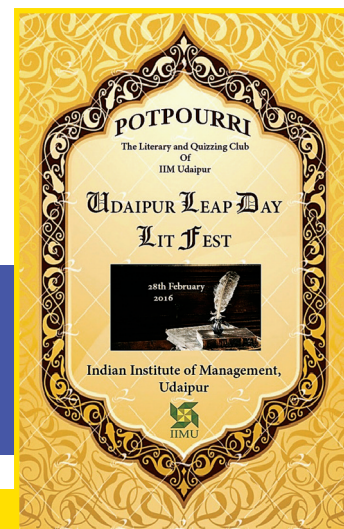

Hindi short story is democratic in its essence

Hemendra Chandalia : Sambalpur, Odisha. Hindi short story has carried the tradition of democracy since its inception. This was stated by Prof. Santosh Bhadoriya, Professor at Allahabad Campus of Mahatma Gandhi Antarashtriy Hindi Vishwavidyalaya, Varanasi. He traced the growth of Hindi short story from Chandradhar Sharma Guleri's 'Usne Kaha Tha' to the works of Uday Prakash mentioning in between the contribution of Prem Chandra, Jai Shankar Prasad, Yashpal, Shiv Poojan Sahay, Agneya, and Krishna Sobti. He said that story moves with society. Whatever happens in society, is reflected in short story also. Dr. Shivnath Pandeya, former Head, Department of Hindi, Mohsin College, Hugli, West Bengal said in his address that the Hindi Short Story has reflected the socio-political transformation of Indian society. He said that Hindi Short story reflected Indian culture when we were not developed. In the present times, when we have achieved development, culture has been lost. Presiding over the session Prof. Hemendra Singh Chandalia, Professor of English at Janardan Rai Nagar Rajasthan Vidyapeeth University Udaipur, said that Hindi short story reflects the picture of the reality of the rural life and the life of peasantry but its English counterpart does not do so. He talked about the tradition of Oral literature and short story in folk literature. Mentioning the contribution of Rajasthan to Hindi short story, he mentioned the names of Dr. Alam Shah Khan, Ratna Kumar Sambharia, Bhagwan Das Morwal, Dr. Gopal Sahar, Dr. Hetu Bhardwaj and Prof. Satyanarayan. A Budget To Fulfill Expectations Of Common Man : CM

Rail Budget 2016

Mewar Received 344 crore

Udaipur : Chief Minister of Rajasthan Smt. Vasundhara Raje has welcomed the Rail Budget introduced by the Union Minister for Railways Shri Suresh Prabhu in the Lok Sabha on Thursday. She said that this budget would prove to be a concrete step in the direction of transforming the Railways.

The Chief Minister said that the budget was important for fulfilling the needs and requirements of Rajasthan as well as the entire country. She said that during the present Union Government regime, allocations for Rajasthan had increased by 186 percent in comparison to the previous government. The previous government made average yearly allocations worth



682 crore rupees for the state, while in the present government this amount had increased to 1,952 crore rupees per year.

Smt. Raje said that this budget would be a good initiative for trans-

formation of infrastructure, modernization and expansion of capacity of trains, satisfaction of passengers, sanitation and better facilities along with expansion of the rail network. She said that the Union Minister's idea of part-

nering with the state governments for expansion of rail network as per the state specific requirements was a welcome move.

The division's budget hoping people got disappointed again. The Minister of Mewar not cleared for a new car and no big announcement. If anything it's a matter of getting back to the task of running the Udaipur-Himmatnagar broad gauge, Prabhu has provided a big Rs 344 crore's 'prasad'. Udaipur divisions except for the isolated new announcements have been noticed on the old. The increasing frequency of trains and to train someone new has not been announced.

According to experts, however, the

old jobs are running, they are made in the railway ministry's pink book. Rs 344 crore for Udaipur-Himmatnagar and Rs 321 crores for Ahmedabad-Modasa-Samlajih has been announced. As such it will catch up this year. The release of funds from the beginning of 2018, the possibilities of this line is also getting stressed. Similarly Mavli-Badi Sadri for passage of about Rs 15 crore has been announced. The rest of this work is yet to begin, but this amount will expedite this work. Ratlam-Banswara-Dungarpur to around Rs 80 crore have been issued. Now it is to see that how much the work is done after the amount of money that's been provided.

Gopal Krishna Sharma took charge

80 kilo watt solar plant began

Udaipur : The 80 kW solar power plant mounted on the roof of Nagar Nigam Bhawan has started its production. About 300 unit electricity is generated per day. Rate per unit of Rs 1,200 a day according to generating electricity. Electricity Committee Chairman Mahesh Trivedi said that the corporation installed on the roof of the building to generate 80 kW solar power plant has started.

Under an estimated Rs 1,200 per day from the plant's electricity is being generated. It is being supplied directly to the power corporation. 40-40 kW have been installed in the two meter readings. Soon the plant will be formally inaugurated. The results of the plant in the coming future, the Corporation may impose large community buildings on small solar plant. From urban plans to add solar power to the watering place.

Poetry of Nirala has a mark of Progressive thought : Chandalia

Sambalpur, Odisha : The poetry of noted Hindi poet of last century Suryakant Tripathi "Nirala" marks the beginning of the progressive strain in Hindi Poetry. He was a pioneer of Chhayavadi, romanticism, but later chose to write progressive poetry. In support of the proletariat. This was stated by Prof. Hemendra Chandalia, visiting Professor, Department of English, Sambalpur University, Odisha on the occasion of Basant Panchami in a seminar on Nirala Jayanti. He said that Nirala was influenced by the rise of Socialist thought after October Revolution.
