Upon transfer of the rented building in own building will be considered a case of relocation.

# A celebration of all that is literary Udaipur Leap-day Lit Fest 2016

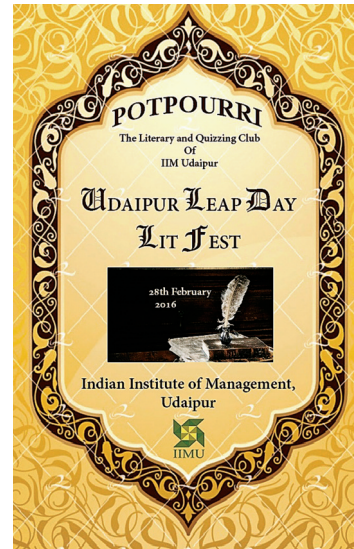
