HDFC Financial Results for the Year Ended March 31, 2016

The Board of Directors of HDFC Bank Limited approved the Bank's (Indian GAAP) results for the quarter ended March 31, 2016 and the audited results for the full year ended March 31, 2016 at their meeting held in Mumbai on Friday, April 22, 2016.

The Bank's total income for the quarter ended March 31, 2016 was 18,862.6 crores,up from 15.570.1 crores for the guarter ended March 31, 2015. Net revenues (net interest income plus other income) increased by 20.3% to `10,319.2crores for the guarter ended March 31, 2016 as against `8.576.9crores for the corresponding quarter of the previous year. Net interest income (interest earned less interest expended) for the quarter ended March 31, 2016 grew by 24.0% to `7,453.3crores, from `6.013.2crores for the quarter ended March 31, 2015 driven by average assets growth of 23.8% and a core net interest margin for the guarter of 4.3%.

Other income (non-interest revenue) at `2,865.9 crores was 27.8% of the net revenues for the quarter ended March31, 2016 and grew by 11.8% over `2,563.8crores in the corresponding quarter ended March 31 2015. The four components of other income for the quarter ended March31, 2016 were fees & com-

THDFC BANK missions of `2,172.4crores (`1,834.8 crores in the corresponding quarter of the previous year), foreign exchange & derivatives revenue of `282.8 crores (`328.7crores for the corresponding quarter of the previous year), gain on revaluation / sale of investments of `115.5 crores (`196.1crores in the corresponding

Sonal Sehgal is super excited to play the character of Kulwant Kaur from Thanda Ghost, she admits that MANTOSTAAN has been an entirely different experience and is a very powerful film indeed. Say Sonal, "My character is very dark and disturbing, somebody who doesn't leave you long after you leave the set. It's a character you haven't seen on screen before". Raghubir Yadav, Shoib Kazmi, Virendra Saxena, Tariq Khan, Raina Bassnet, Sakshi bhatt and Rahat Kazmi himself have played key characters in the film.

Saadat Hassan Manto was heartbroken and



shaken by the trauma the partition brought in its wake, and some of his best pieces revolve around what he saw during those horrific months. The stories of 'Mantostan' are about the single-minded dedication with which men killed men, the remorse felt by some and the tears shed by murderers.

Background: In the riots, which preceded the partition in the Punjab Province, between 200,000 and 2,000,000 people were killed in the retributive genocide between the religions, estimates 14 million Hindus, Sikhs and Muslims were displaced during the partition; it was the largest mass migration in human history.
