



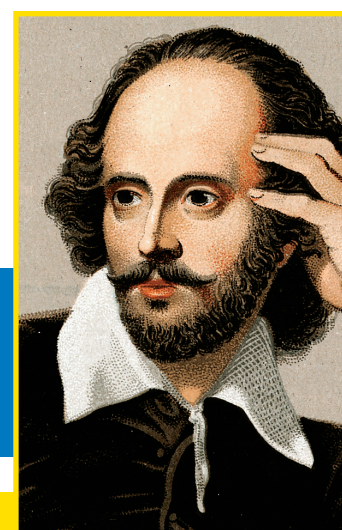

Focus On Pleasant Environment For Tourists - CM

Udaipur: Chief Minister Smt. Vasundhara Raje has said that in view of possibilities of growth of heritage tourism in Rajasthan efforts are being made for multi-dimensional development of tourism sector. The state government was focusing on creation of a pleasant environment for domestic and foreign tourists along with new centres of attraction by way of organizing fairs, festivals, celebrations and other such events.

Smt. Raje was addressing the inauguration session of the 5th Annual Convention of Indian Heritage Hotels Association (IHHA) at Udaipur City Palace on Sunday.

The CM said that with presence of various factors of heritage tourism such as art, folk

culture, tradition and history, Rajasthan was a choice of all international and domestic travellers. She said that it was the home for 70% heritage properties in the country and efforts were being made with fresh new thinking to give this legacy a new identity by way of organizing various national and international events on PPP mode, which yielded encouraging results. She offered for partnering in more such events.

Smt. Raje said that innovative attempts were needed for promotion of tourism in Rajasthan. She called upon the members of the industry for innovations in conservation of heritage and development of tourism and give suggestions to the state government in this

JRN retains Deemed status

Udaipur: Honorable Supreme Court in a recent decision has retained the 'Deemed University' status of Janardan Rai Nagar Rajasthan Vidyapeeth University. The court has canceled Tondon and Office committee reports in this matter. The NAAC had awarded B grade to the university which gave the university a great relief. The Supreme court in this matter has found the NAAC rating of B grade to be correct. This actually has secured the status of the University. All this began in the year 2010 when the HRD min-

istry had constituted a committee to review status of 144 deemed universities. The committee had recommended to derecognize 40 universities. These universities including JRN approached the court and requested to get a review done by NAAC. NAAC in its report awarded B grade to the university. Following this, the honorable court has restored the deemed status of the University. This has opened way for grant for university which was blocked after the recommendations of Tondon committee. Professor

Sarangdevot told that this victory is result of hard work and dedication of fellow members of the university. He revealed that the University missed the A grade only by 0.16 points which will be covered by next review. The VC further informed that all preparations were done keeping UGC standards in view. Talking about the achievements of the University, he said that for the first time in the University's history, national level games were organized in which an MOU was signed with Universities of America, Japan, and Australia.



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
