People dying of hunger, govt busy opening-closing palace gates- Pilot

Udaipur: Friday was a day of hat tic politics for BJP & congress Afull of surprises for the poor tribal people in Udaipur as VIPs and visitors been lined their homes and enquired their well being.

In two different trips Minister of Forest, Mines and Environment Rajkumar Rinwa and Rajasthan Congress President Sachin Pilot visited Padawali and Naal villages in the area that were recently hit by the seasonal diseases that killed 11 persons including four children in a fortnight.

Rinwa arrived first, took stock of the medical facilities to the victims and announced help to the affected families, Pilot attacked the state government for its apathy and concern for the deprived community. He also expressed shock over the apathy of the

RSS leaders who were in Udaipur for a national meet but didnt care to visit the victims.

Rinwa inspected the relief camps being held at the primary health center and government school by the medical department. Villagers told the minister that the calamity had taken place due to contamination of water and outspread of seasonal diseases after heavy rains. The victims couldn't be taken to hospitals timely due to the water clogged roads. Rinwa expressed grief on the situation and instructed the collector and medical officers for vigilant monitoring of the health care facilities in the area.

He announced compensation of 20 thousand rupees each to the affected families and allotment of houses for them under the PM Awaas



Yojana. He also inspected the drinking water facilities in both villages. Meanwhile the PCC chief expressed dissention with the governmental intervention on the situation.

Hitting hard on the chief minister Pilot said " Chief Minister Vasundhara Raje was in Udaipur to attend a program

held in the City Palace a week ago but she did not care to peep into the dingy huts of the tribals who died of hunger, seasonal diseases and lack of timely medical aid". Pilot spoke to many residents and enquired of the medical facilities available in the area. Later addressing a press conference Pilot

said that the conditions of the tribal people are grim. Many people do not have access to drinking water, enough food to eat, they don't even have containers to store grains". Demanding a high committee enquiry in the death case, Pilot said that people are terrified as they have been threatened

not to open their mouth or share their agony with anyone.

later talking to media person in circuit house he said "I am not here to grab this unfortunate incident for political motives but to know the ground realities of the various government schemes and claims. The needy section is not really benefitting of the programs but the govt is too busy in opening and shutting of the royal palaces and forts to see their plight. If the CM had some compassion and mercy, she should have visited them instead of visiting the palace" Pilot hurled. Former MP Raghuvver Singh Meena, ex legislators Gajendra Singh Shaktawat, Mangilal Garasiya, MLA Heeralal Darangi were among the persons who accompanied Pilot

Rahul Gandhi should respect judicial proceedings, says Vaidya

Udaipur: All India Prachar Pramukh of the Rashtriya Swayam sevak Sangh (RSS) Dr Manmohan Vaidya advised congress vice president Rahul Gandhi to respect the judicial proceedings of the country. Dr Vaidya was speaking to the media to brief about the two days national co-ordination committee meeting of the RSS that began here on Thursday. Mohan Bhagwat, the RSS chief, Ram Madhav and Ramlal, national general secretaries of the BJP are here to participate in the convention.

During the press conference, When Vaidya was asked on Rahul Gandhi's firm stand on his allegations of RSS involvement in the assassination of Mahatma Gandhi, the RSS leader said that "Rahul should understand that it is the court which has to decide in the matter. RSS's name has never come up even once either in the prosecution or during any of the court trials, hence he should respect the court proceedings".

When asked whether Nathuram Godse was a member of the RSS at the time of Bapu's assassination, Vaidya answered diplomatically " Yes, he was a member and so were many other people at that time. RSS has a tradition that those who do not actively participate in its affairs, no longer remain its member and Godse too wasn't an active member". When asked whether Godse was expelled, Vaidya didn't comment. He kept the briefing a very short affair and winded the meet within 5 minutes.

" This is not any decision making meeting but an organizational convention to receive and share feedbacks from our members who move around the country through out the year.

Following his passion, in 2009 when he applied for admission in a three-year engineering course of diploma in directorate of technical education, he was denied outright. He was apprised that the institutes that come under the directorate do not have teachers to teach

deaf-mute students. But his father Mr. Badri Lal Kharol did not give up. His father got association of a friend Vasudev chaturvedi. They appealed to the Prime Minister, court, and gave memorandums in department of social justice and empowerment.

During this struggle they reached Vidya Bhawan polytechnic where principal Dr. Anil Mehta agreed to admit Prakash. Then administrative office Aditi Mehta also endorsed the admission to Prakash. The government of India then directed education secretary to arrange for the admission of

Prakash. After all the struggle, the directorate of technical education agreed to admit Prakash. Vidya Bhawan, though had no special teacher for Prakash, they still took up the challenge and started educating him. College requested for additional time for Prakash which court agreed. He got the privilege of additional time in his last year but he did not take the advantage. The way Prakash braved the challenge of education is an epitome for one and all.
