FBI clears Hillary Clinton again following review of new emails

New York: Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Director James Comey informed lawmakers that the agency had not changed its opinion that Hillary Clinton should not face criminal charges after a review of new emails. "Based on our review, we have not changed our conclusions that we expressed in July," the CNN quoted Comey as saying in the new letter written by him to congressional committee chairmen. Last month, a bombshell was dropped by Comey on the presidential race as he had sent a letter to Congress saying the FBI had discovered emails in a separate investigation that could be connected to the now closed probe of whether the classified information was mis-



handled by Clinton. The news could help Clinton put to rest a controversy that has dogged her in the 2016 race's closing days, helping Trump narrow a polling gap

nationally and in key battleground states. The FBI's handling of the matter was assailed by Trump. However, he did not directly address Comey's statement at

a rally in Sterling Heights, Michigan. "You can't review 6,50,000 new emails in eight days. You can't do it, folks," Trump said, adding, "Hillary Clinton is guilty.

She knows it, the FBI knows it, the people know it, and now it's up to the American people to deliver justice at the ballot box on November 8." Comey's handling of the review was blasted by Dianne Feinstein, the top Democrat on the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence. Feinstein in a statement said, "Today's letter makes Director Comey's actions nine days ago even more troubling. There's no doubt that it created a false impression about the nature of the agency's inquiry." The new emails were found by the FBI as part of its separate investigation into a sexting incident by Anthony Weiner, the estranged husband of top Clinton aide Huma Abedin.

While explaining how the conclusion was reached so quickly law enforcement officials said the thousands of new emails were mostly personal and duplicates of what had already been seen. The probe is considered to be over with regard to Clinton. However, with not all the deleted emails recovered and not all the devices in FBI's possession, it is always possible that something else could turn up that would need more review. The Justice Department said in a brief statement released on Sunday afternoon, "The Department of Justice and the FBI dedicated all necessary resources to conduct this review expeditiously."

Seminar on GST in UCCI



Udaipur: "The biggest flaw of current tax system is that it covers a low percentage of people in its ambit. This forces the honest taxpayer to shell out more money. This scheme also has failed miserably to curb the tax-theft. GST definitely will expand the tax ambit which will cause a reduction in taxable money," these were the views by MC Dinesh in a seminar on GST in the UCCI. An interactive seminar was organized in the Udaipur Chamber of Commerce Industry last week in which president of Federation of Karnataka chamber of commerce and industry Mr. MC Dinesh and co-chairman of ASSOCHAM Dr. Jacob Crasta were chief speakers. Mr Dinesh revealed that GST is nothing revolutionary, rather

it is there in 170 countries already. In India every state had its own tax structure. After GST, a uniformity will be achieved which will help country grow well. He said that in the new system, there will be only two types of rates-one for common man and other for businessman. The other speaker Dr. Jacob Crasta said that Karnataka is a leading state in terms of industrial and economic development. He also revealed that Karnataka's share in income of the country is highest. "Still the fact is that only 10 percent business man are paying taxes regularly and honestly. With GST, the ambit of tax payers will expand and it will be real Ram Rajya in the country" he added.

Website which will empower women the Right way

Every house needs domestic help, every office needs a receptionist, every beauty parlour a beautician and every boutique a tailor. Neither there's a dearth of jobs nor skilled women workers. However, the gap between the women in need of jobs and those who can provide jobs is immense. As informed by Archana Shaktawat founder - Jobs4her is a social and non-profit initiative of bridging the gap between women in needs of jobs and Women in need of jobs with People who can employ them. Women from different working sector like domestic help, tailoring, academics, IT sectors jobs, and professional jobs etc. will be registered. For registration address proof and photo ID is compulsory. Moreover, police verification will be done for each registered lady. The woman's skills and work area preference is noted along with her contact details. Whenever, there's a requirement depending upon her skills and work area preference, the lady is informed through call

and SMS. The caller details are shared with her. The people who will call Jobs4her will also be registered with them. The website has been launched on trial basis. Because of security reasons, only basic information of the lady will be visible on the website and further queries employers will have to call Jobs4her. **How did Jobs4her start?** Archana Shaktawat & Saroj Patel have been involved in social activities for almost 4yrs. They started with opening Divya Mother's Milk Bank. After successfully opening it, they moved on to a different project of empowering women. Being empowered women themselves they wanted to help those who less fortunate and needed help. Founders of Jobs4her - Archana Shaktawat & Saroj Patel, have been running a voluntarily mission called Sexual Offences Awareness Program (SOAP) for almost 2yrs. They educate girls at school and college level on various types of sexual offences, laws related to these crimes and pre-



cautionary measures that can be taken. Archana Shaktawat added before starting they meet various lawyers and empowered and went to police station to understand why women are suffering more than men. They realized that women are neither aware of their rights nor do they know what to do if sexual crimes happens to them. That was the birthchild of SOAP. Saroj Patel further stated that women have skills and ability however due to lack of opportunities and sheer lack of awareness they fail to excel. She also stated that in the process of creating aware-

ness, SOAP helped numerous women by counseling them, helping them report the crime, meet the right lawyers and so forth. They were dependent on their families for their financial needs. Thus, the idea struck that why not create jobs for women and empower them the right way. Jobs4her is connecting Women who can work with those who can employ them. The people of Udaipur who are creating employment opportunities for them. By giving these women financial independence (in terms of their salaries) you are empowering them.
