## Maize's important role in food security of the country - Sandhu



**Udaipur:** The three day Maize research workshop at Maharana Pratap Agriculture and Technology University, Udaipur was inaugurated on Sunday. This workshop is being organized in the joint working of Maharana Pratap Agriculture and Technology University, Udaipur and All India Maize Research Institute, Ludhiana.

In this workshop, more than 200 senior maize scientists from different states of Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Assam, West Bengal, Haryana, Arunachal Pradesh and Rajasthan are participating. In the inauguration program, the guests look at Rajasthani colors.

The chief guest of the workshop, Dr. J.S. Sandhu, Deputy Director General, Indian Council of Agricultural Research, said that this relat-

ed project has done a lot of work to connect most of the agricultural scientists in the country. He said that Maize has an important role in establishing food security in our country. He said that the production of most maize in the country is year-wise and in such areas, the focus of the production of hybrid species of maize and the production of quality protein maize through biotechnology will be taken care of. He emphasized on the techniques of plastics, weed control, smart agriculture and precision farming techniques in maize.

Professor Uma Shankar Sharma presiding over the program. Said that the production of 960 million MT corn is being done in VI and in which our country's contribution is 2.4 percent which is very urgent enough to increase. Pro. Sharma said that districts of Bhilwara, Udaipur, Chittorgarh,

Banswara, Dungarpur and Pratapgarh in the six districts of Southern Rajasthan are leading districts of maize production. While making significant contribution to the country's maize production, MPUAT recently introduced two hybrid species of maize: Pratap hybrid maize - 1 and Pratap K.P.M. Hybrid-1 has developed, which is quite popular in southern Rajasthan. In the last two years, V8 has developed Pratap hybrid maize-3 and Pratap Maize-9 by the college.

Deputy Director General of the Program, Mr. I.S. Solanki, while addressing the present scientists, said that it is the largest coordinated project in the country, with only 32 such private sector producer companies affiliated with 32 centers

At the inaugural function, the guests of Indian seed corporation limited Uttarakhand,

Aadhar Seeds Ltd, for the contribution of maize production and research in maize production and research. Udaipur Rajasthan, CCS Hissar Krishn V. VI College, Uchhani Karnal, P.A.U. Ludhiana, Telangana Krishi VI College, Hyderabad was awarded with a citation. On this occasion, IIM Five publications were also released on topics related to Annual Report of Prakash Prakash, News Letter, Pest and Pest Management in Maize.

In the beginning of the program, Dr. S. S. Bourdak gave a welcome welcome and the project director of Indian Institute of Maize Research, Dr. Sujay Rakshit presented an annual report of all the centers.

Workshop program secretary Dr Dilip Singh told that the total production of maize will be technical related discussions in 9 seasons. This is being done to create a very important action plan for the workshop maize research and pest disease control.

In all the sessions, scientists will discuss new centers for their centers, achievements and the coming year. **New Delhi:** Dr Pawanindra Lal, Director Professor of Surgery at Maulana Azad Medical College (MAMC) has been awarded with the Prestigious "Dr B.C Roy Award" for the year 2016 - for excellence in the field of Medicine. The award was presented by President, Shri Pranab Mukherjee.

Dr Lal was felicitated with the coveted award for "Recognizing the best talents in encouraging the development of specialties in different branches in Medicine".

Dr Pawanindra Lal is Director Professor of Surgery at Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi. An award winning graduate from MAMC and post graduate from UCMS, Delhi, Dr Lal joined his alma mater in 1999 after having worked as a faculty in GMC Chandigarh. Keenly interested in teaching and laparoscopic surgery, he has more than 80 publications in national and international journals and more than 200 paper presentations. He is a member of all national surgical bodies as well as ELISA (Asia), ALS (UK) and SAGES (USA) and a fellow of three Royal College of Surgeons in UK and also of the American College of Surgeons. He is the head of the Clinical Skills Centre and leads the Minimal Access Surgery training programme, both his founding contributions.

His academic talent has been internationally recognized and he is the first Indian working in India who has contributed a chapter in the 25th Edition of Bailey & Love's Short Practice of Surgery in 2008. He has also authored a Handbook on Critical Care and Fluid Management in 2008. He is possibly the only Indian with more than 10 original publications in Surgical Endoscopy, the official journal of SAGES, USA.

The Bidhan Chandra Roy Award was instituted in 1976 in the memory of renowned physician and freedom fighter B C Roy by Medical Council of India. It is the highest award that is bestowed upon on a Medical person practicing in India.
