CONVICTS OF POCSO ACT SHOULD BE DEPRIVED OF THE RIGHT TO MERCY PETITION: PRESIDENT

Mount Abu: President Kovind while speaking at the inauguration ceremony of the 2-day National Convention on Empowerment of Women for Social Transformation at Abu Road, the International headquarters of the Brahmakumari institution in Rajasthan. Said that

"Many things are being suggested in this context. The accused been given the right to mercy petition in the constitution and I have said that it should be reconsidered. The right to mercy petition should be denied for the incidents which occur in the POCSO Act. They do not need any such right", he stated.

"Now it all depends on our Parliament because there is a constitution, there is a constitution amendment but we all are thinking in that direction", he further added.

He said that the incidents of demonic attacks on daughters of India shakes the soul of the country and that the women's safety is a very serious matter. He added that a lot of work has been done in this regard, but a lot of work still

remains to be done.

President Kovind said that the Brahma Kumaris Institute is playing its effective role on the world stage through more than eight thousand service centers in about 140 countries of the world. The institute has enhanced the pride of India all over the world. In the fields of women's empowerment, environmental protection, water conservation, energy conservation, sanitation, the institute is playing an important role in bringing about social change. MAKING UDAIPUR A SMART CITY

It augurs well for lakecity as now the new Mayor of Municipal Corporation G.S. Tank is an experienced person who had worked as chairman, Rajasthan Public Service Commission and Chief Engineer, PWD. Known for his integrity, he intends to make the Corporation play an activity role in making Udaipur a smart city by taking full support of the opposition members. He says that he would be always available to meet people. His priorities include road network, drainage system, traffic, parking, elevated flyover and cleanliness. Retired engineers and other experts as well as the public are to be involved in the process of planning.

Even earlier roads have been a priority for the Corporation and 8 crore were set aside for building new roads where they were badly damaged and 4 crore were allotted for paver and patch work. According to Manohar Choudhary, the work could not progress speedily due to the long spell of the monsoon this year and the hard rocks in several areas. The BJP did not fare well as expected probably due to the dissatisfaction of the public about roads.



Parking facilities also need a lot of improvement. At Roadways bus stand one has to pass through bushes and the vehicles are covered with dust. Parking near Seva Ashram Bridge has not been given to a contractor and the place is very dirty. Information about parking charges should be provided at Bank Tiraha parking. Parking is not systematic near Dena Bank, Delhigate. Helpline number for parking complaints should be provided and there should be CCTV cameras for safety of the parked vehicles.

On the positive side, the work of removing encroachments has already started. Under the leadership of Deputy Mayor Paras Singhvi, a group of persons cooking food near Sukhadia, Statue, near Sukhadia Circle were evicted. Then the "Jhule-Chakri" near the proposed food court were removed. There is need for constant monitoring. If there are sponsors to look after such places, they can be kept in proper condition.

It's the time to turn waste into gold: Sri Sri Ravi Shankar

New Delhi: With a mission to spread awareness about Clean & Green Delhi under Swachh Bharat Mission and to provide a robust waste management solution in the capital, Art of Living & NDMC have joined hands to process 1 Ton wet waste per day. They have launched first of its kind, "Swachh Composting Plant" that will produce 100 percent organic compost. The plant has been established by New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) in collaboration with Sri Sri Rural Development Programme Trust.

Governor, Delhi Shri Anil Bajjal & Chairperson-NDMC, Shri Dharmendra. The plant will dispose of 1000 kg waste every day and produce 300 kg of organic compost without using any chemical treatment.
