## Babbler bird of new species found in Udaipur

**Udaipur:** The discovery of a new babbler species, has recently added a new name to Rajasthan's rich biodiversity, and its credit goes to Udaipur. It is a small resident bird discovered puff throated babbler, whose scientific name is Pelornis ruficeps.



This new bird species has been found in Gamda of Phulwari's Nal Wildlife Sanctuary located in the Udaipur district. It has been planted by Dr. Dharmendra Khandal, a noted environmental scientist from Rajasthan and a field biologist from Tiger Watch, environmental scientists Dr. Satish Sharma and Harkirat Singh Sangha working for biodiversity conservation in South Rajasthan. A detailed report on this new achievement has been published in Part 5 of Issue 16 of 'Indian Birds'.

This bird happens - Udaipur's ornithologist Dr. Satish Sharma said that it is a member of the wobbler class. Whose beak and legs are light pink. The color of the chestnut is soft chocolate, and the color of the back is dull black, the throat is entirely white, and there are deep stripes on the chat. The white line black above the eye extends long and extends to the back of the neck. It stays in pairs or small groups and eats insects lying on the ground in the clump of leaves falling in the forest. This type of species has been found in Polo Forest in Vijayanagar, Gujarat.

This babbler species is found in Satpura Bihar and Orissa plateau regions, Eastern and the Western Ghats regions, Rajmahal Pahadia (Central Western Bihar), Kerala's Palakkad (Palghat) region, Chitteri Pahadia, etc. Local bird lovers have expressed happiness for the first and new discovery in the state.

## Organizational meeting organized in UCCI

**Udaipur:** It is within the jurisdiction of the Central Government to declare any airport as an international airport and start operating international flights. "Infrastructure can be developed accordingly after the announcement."

Mr. D.K. Kamra gives the above information to UCCI members during a discussion in the Pyrotech Tempsons Auditorium of the Chamber building.

North Regional Executive Director of Airport Authority of India, Shri D.K. Kamra, held at UCCI in a discussion meeting. Director of Udaipur Airport, Mrs. Nandita Bhatt, and Airport Officer Mr. Marcus was also present in this discussion.

UCCI President, Mr. Komal Kothari, while well coming said that for a long time, the suggestion of making Udaipur Airport an international airport has been submitted by the UCCI to the concerned Ministry and Department, but due to various reasons, this proposal is still tangible

Shri Kamra informed that after the Central Government declares Udaipur Airport as an International Airport, action can be taken from the State Government to transfer land for the expansion of infrastructure at the Secretary level. Besides, other minor obstacles near the airport can be overcome locally.

The main problem that has come up is expected to be resolved through the state government. Since currently, the runway length of Udaipur Airport is 2744 meters; out of that, only 2281 meters are currently being used. It mainly faced two problems that the power department's high-tension line should be shifted from there and secondly, a crusher near the runway should either be reduced to four meters or shifted away from the runway. This will enable the use of about 1500 feet (463 meters) of the runway, which is not working right now. With its help, large aircraft will be able to land smoothly in Udaipur. Along with this, airport officials also informed that acquiring 145 acres of land for the airport expansion is going on, and efforts will be made to complete this work as soon as possible so that Udaipur's dream of a fully international airport will be fulfilled. With this, the industries, hoteliers, and tourism business of the Udaipur division and the general public of Udaipur city will benefit.

The Chairman, Shri Komal Kothari, expressed UCCI's resolve to strive with full dedication to make Udaipur Airport an international airport and called upon the cooperation of all to provide it with the Central and State Government. The program was conducted by Honorary General Secretary Dr. Anshu Kothari did.

## Corona Test @PIMS

**Udaipur:** The state-of-the-art Corona Investigation Laboratory has been set up at the Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS), Hospital, Umrda under the aegis of public concerns during the Corona epidemic.

All the guidelines issued by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) will be followed during the corona investigation.
