Birla said that they would provide a pulse oximeter, digital thermometer, mask, and other resources to these soldiers to help them get proper treatment by immediately examining the symptoms in a patient.

Udaipur: Like the second wave of corona epidemic in the last one and a half months in many states of India, including Rajasthan, the scarcity of oxygen and life-saving medicines started coming up from all over the country. Rajasthan also not remained untouched by this. If patients could not find a place in the hospital, then they could not find oxygen cylinders. In such a situation, Armaan Jain, the state general secretary of Rajasthan Youth



Congress, comes forward and till late night stands ready to help the needy. So far, he has helped around 500 people.

Due to the black marketing of other life-saving injections, including Remdesivir, in various parts of the country, including Rajasthan, the families had to eat around to save the dying people. Somewhere people had to suffer due to lack of blood. Some plasma was craving to eat even poor. Horrific scenes were seen everywhere, but most people could not get help on the land, and many cities of southern Rajasthan were facing similar problems. Many politicians and legislators' phones were coming off for fear of illness, and the public was pleading for help on social media.

To save the people from this kind of trouble, the National President of Youth Congress, B Srinivas, delivered life-saving medicines, including oxygen, to people all over India, including Delhi. Seeing him as her source of inspiration, Armaan Jain started responding to calls for help on social media tweeters and other platforms. At that time, barely a few people were coming forward to help people on social media in Rajasthan. They made people one day and night to get plasma, blood, life-saving medicines, and oxygen cylinders with injections, oxygen beds, and ventilators in the hospital. Gradually, people started asking for relief by directly tagging them for help on social media.

On platforms like Twitter, the condition was that after searching on keywords like Udaipur, now Armaan Jain's tales of relief started trending. A series started early morning, and people's calls to be attended by 2 o'clock in the night. Gradually, the matter started reaching other districts of Rajasthan and then came to Armaan Jain, requesting help from many districts. Along with many senior Congress leaders, leaders of other parties also tagged him for help. The caravan of help was increasing now.

Gradually, other organizations and teams were also impressed by this action plan of Armaan and started working on social media for help. But the credit for its introduction is being given only to his action plan in Rajasthan.

Narayan Seva's Oxygen-Meal and Corona Kit Service Continues Continuously

Udaipur: the second wave of Udaipur, Corona, the services of oxygen, food, and corona medicine kit delivery services from e Narayana Seva Institute.

Institute President Prashant Agrawal said that on Saturday, the seeker team gave 1052 food packs to the families of the Corona-infected families and took nine oxygen cylinders and 22 Corona medicine kits for free to the family members of the ailing. He said that on the helpline number of the institute, more than 150 calls and WhatsApp are coming every day to the help seekers. Various institutes are also carrying out ambulance service, sanitation service, ration distribution, etc., with full service. It is noteworthy that apart from Udaipur, the institute is also running free services from 17 April in Meerut, Parbhani, Baroda, where thousands of people are benefiting daily.

Innovation: BTU's affiliated engineering college makes oxygen concentrator

Community engineering is the innovation of true engineering: Vice Chancellor Dr. Ambarish Sharan



Bikaner, The whole world is facing huge medical challenges today due to coronavirus. In such a situation, India is not untouched by this. The second wave of coronavirus in India has created a huge problem for the people here due to acute oxygen shortage and excessive demand, Bikaner Technical University has brought relief news with its innovations to solve this problem. Assistant Public Relations Officer Vikram Rathore said that the team of Raj Engineering College Jodhpur affiliated to Bikaner Technical University has done the work of making a prototype of homemade oxygen concentrator at a very low price. This concentrator can provide more than twice as much oxygen as the contractors available from reputed companies in the market. It produces 12 to 14 liters of oxygen per minute.

This allows two patients to be combined together. In today's situation where corona epidemic patients need the most oxygen on time and vice versa availability is the lowest, this innovation will prove to be a boon for corona patients at such a time.

Water purifier equipment readily available in the market and built at a cost of just Rs 10,000 to 12,000, this oxygen concentrator will serve as a lifeline for the corona patients fighting for the war of death. The team of Registrar Pankaj Sankhala, Mahendra Sankhala and Harsh Vardhan Sharma, under the direction of Dr. Rajuram Chaudhary, Chairman of Raj Group of Institutions, jointly prepared this Homemade Oxygen Concentrator from Jugaad through hard efforts of 8 days. This machine can produce oxygen at speeds of up to 10-12 liters per minute and it can be easily operated compared to the concentrators of different companies in the market. As soon as possible, his team is changing the design of the machine to create a new model in which oxygen can be made available to at least 2 patients, thereby reducing the current price per person. This project was being worked on for

the past many times, using the native jugaad; this innovation was implemented by the construction team. With its successful use, an alternative has been made to manufacture oxygen concentrators that are accessible to the common man through engineering. It has been sent the innovation for approval of the State Government, after its approval, the production of it will be started.

Vice Chancellor Dr. Ambarish Sharan Vidyarthi congratulated the team for this public utility innovation of the associated engineering college of Bikaner Technical University and described it as an important step towards self-reliant India campaign. New concepts of social engineering have developed through innovations in engineering, which have become the foundation of our human society. Realizing the problem of human society and developing solutions is the true engineering. It can be further developed and used at a greater level with patents and industrial production. The University will provide full support to promote such inventions.

Director Academic Dr. Yadunath Singh said that innovation is most important in the progress of a country and innovation only develops entrepreneurship of the student. Everyone will benefit from the creation of this homemade oxygen concentrator, facing challenges through creative ability and innovation based on science and technology.
