

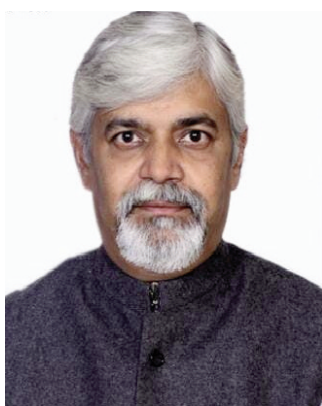
Chancellors and educationists of the country brainstormed on the National Education Policy in the “Global Mahakumbh” of Higher and Technical Education
