

Action will be taken against those who indulge in unwanted activities

Bhilwara: (Pawan Garg)

Strict action will now be taken against those who indulge in unwanted activities under the guise of journalism and they will be excommunicated. Along with this, an 11-member committee was also constituted to take quick action on the complaints of such people.

This decision was taken unanimously in a meeting organized by the Press Club on Sunday.

General Secretary Rajesh Methani said that because of the fingers being raised on the credibility of the journalists after the incident in the transport market on Saturday, in the emergency meeting on Sunday, the journalists unanimously decided to take strict action against such so-called journalists (Lapka gang). Under this, it was also decided

that against such so-called fake people, the Press Club would file a case against the victim as a complainant himself.

On this occasion

President Sukhpal Jat united with everyone and asked them to boycott such people by showing their promptness in taking action. Jat has appealed to the traders and common people of Bhilwara that they should not be afraid of such fake people and come out firmly against them and inform the Press Club about their actions so that the traders can work fearlessly. He also told that the Press Club is not at all with such so-called journalists.

Senior journalist Mahesh Aggarwal said that the compulsory registration of every journalist associated with jour-

nalism in the Press Club should be implemented. He also suggested boycotting the journalists for doing unwanted acts.

Senior journalist Kailash Trivedi also suggested taking appropriate action against the so-called journalists.

Journalist Prahlad Teli said that after the Corona period there has been a steady increase in such incidents which needs to be stopped. Mrs. Madhu Jaju demanded the ex-communication of such journalists from the press family. Senior journalist Rajkumar Mali suggested bringing blackmailed journalists before the administration. Also suggested filing a case against those doing illegal journalism on social media. Senior journalist Sushil Chauhan suggested joint action to check the action being taken by the district



authorities on the information of such fake journalists. Legal Adviser Shailendra Verma suggested that a helpline number should be made available to the general public for complaints of such fake journalists and the general public and businessmen should be made aware of the action taken by the Press Club. Senior journalist Om Kasara also expressed concern over the questions being raised in the press due

to the so-called journalists and demanded action against such Lapka gang.

Journalist Dilshad Khan said that some people are distributing press cards in fake form by forming so-called organizations and asked to take action against them. Along with this, strict action should be taken against whoever is found indulging in unwanted activities.

A discussion meeting was held regarding facts and geographical places. The director of the film Vicky Ranawat and the producer of the film Sunil Jain, Kawaljit Singh Ranawat told that Pradeep Singh Purawat, Executive President of Bhupal Nobles Institute, Consultant Pratap Singh Jhala Talavda, Balwant Singh Jhala, Saral Ranawat, Gunwant Singh Jhala, Maruti Nandan Pachauri, Line Producer Subhash Soral, a well-known historian of Mewar, especially who did research work on the Maharana Pratap was discussed openly and extensively through questions. In this discussion, Dr. Mohabbat Singh Rathore of Pratap Research Foundation, Dr. Dev Kothari, Prof. Girish Nath Mathur, Dr. Rajendra Nath Purohit, Dr. J.K. Vicky Ranawat told that a film will



be made on the memorable Veer Shiromani Maharana Pratap in the morning, which will be undeniable and based on facts. Most of the shooting of the film will also take place at those historical places where Veer Shiromani Maharana Pratap spent his struggle and fought historical wars. In the film, the journey of Maharana Pratap from the time of his birth to his journey to death will be presented in great detail. Researched Maharana Pratap for about 7 years and then discussed with Dr. Rajshekhar Vyas. Suddenly his health deteriorated and he was admitted to the hospital. He told that such touching aspects of Maharana Pratap's life will also be presented in the film which the common man is not yet aware of. VFX will be used in film shooting to present landscapes that are 500 years old. Efforts will be made to show it in the film. It is impossible to tell the history of 500 years in 3 hours but still the main purpose of his life, events will be included. He said that making this film is very historic and hard work because in this film it will be a big challenge to bring alive that historical place, that tradition, and language of 500 years ago on screen. Maharana Pratap is the father of the hikatha. Although

Maharana Pratap fought many wars in his lifetime, the main three major battles are the Battle of Haldighati, the Battle of Chittor, and the Battle of Diver. Shooting him will be a very historic task. Shooting will start by March 2022 and will be released in the year 2023. Shooting will be done in Mewar and Jaipur. Along with this, local artists will also be given a chance. He told me that I am a Rajput myself, so I care about how their dress and gait should be. The work of auditions for the film is going on in full swing. The Katha has been written by Dr. Rajshekhar Vyas, screenplay by Vicky Ranawat, Saral Ranawat, and Rajshekhar Vyas. Pratapsinh Talavda, a descendant of Jhala Mann, the film's advisor, told that in the spiritual world, the name of Meera Bai, Maharana Pratap is taken today in the hikatha of the world. Against tradition, he never did any disobedience Nazis to date.

The hikatha of Mewar has the highest place in the world. This has also been talked about with Mahendra Singh of the Mewar royal family. Whatever is real will be shown in the film. Be the character as it is. Shooting should be done at geographical locations only. Film with facts and show it.
