Stature of the chief minister Ashok Gehlot grows more with Jaipur rally

Jaipur: With the success of the grand rally held in Jaipur protesting price-rises under the shadow of a new variant of corona-omicron and a large number of people attending it, the stature of chief minister Ashok Gehlot has grown much more. This grand rally was attended by national president Sonia Gandhi, former president Rahul Gandhi, general secretary Priyanka Gandhi, chief minister of Chhattisgarh Bhupesh Baghel, many other big leaders and congress workers from Rajasthan and the whole of the nation. Punjab chief minister Charanjit Singh Channi could not attend the rally as his chartered plane reached Jaipur late.

Political experts agree that once again congress high command showed its confidence in chief minister Ashok Gehlot who is going to celebrate the

third anniversary of his government and entrusted him the responsibility to hold the national rally against inflation that remained successful increasing his dimension in the party tremendously.

Tremendous preparations for this rally were jointly made by KC Venugopal, organization general secretary of All India Congress Committee, Ajay Makan, state in charge, chief minister Ashok Gehlot, state party president Govind Datasara and other office bearers.

Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot expressed his gratitude to Sonia Gandhi, interim president of all India congress committee, Rahul Gandhi and Priyanka Gandhi to select Rajasthan to hold the national rally and termed it a wrong practice on not to grant permission to hold a national rally

in Delhi by central home department.

He said that in view of the wishes of the fellow countrymen, the rally should have been organized in Delhi only, but chockablocked with vanity, NDA has set a wrong convention by not doing so. Gehlot said that the central government is not listening to the general public and price-rises continue to go on increasing. He further said that the center is not listening to common man and farmers and has become arrogant. He warned that the public will teach the lesson in time to come. He stressed that no one should go so conceited, rather should listen to the problems of the people politely and render solutions to it, but the central government is not doing so.

It is worth mentioning that in the ensuing two years, in



December 2023 state assembly elections are going to be held in Rajasthan in which looking into infighting among BJP state leaders, it is sure the congress party will be benefited with this. It is highly talked about in the political circles that with this rally not only the sta-

tus of Ashok Gehlot has gone up, but the trust and respect for him has also gone up multifold before party high command. At the same time, this rally has turned into a medium to bring closer Ashok Gehlot and Sachin Pilot and exhibit unity of the congress party.

Rahul Gandhi is seen in a new look in the grand rally at Jaipur on eliminate inflation

Rahul Gandhi, former president of congress was seen in a new look in a grand rally of congress organized at Jaipur. In this rally he remained more attacking on the Modi government in the presence of Sonia Gandhi, national president of congress in the elimination rally held in a stadium located at Vidyadhar Nagar, Jaipur.

Rahul Gandhi awesomely surmounted Modi government on the issues of inflation and Hindutva and attacked him sharply.

Calling him a Hindu and termed Bhartiya Janata Party (BJP) a staunch Hindutwadi. He said that there is a big difference between being Hindu and Hindutwadi. Mahatma Gandhi was a Hindu, but Nathuram Godse was a

Rajasthan Loktantrik Morcha Demands Repeal of Labour Codes

Udaipur: Rajasthan Loktantrik Morcha, a joint front of Janata Dal Secular, Communist Party of India, Communist Party of India (Marxist), Communist Party of India 9 Marxist-Leninist, Samajwadi Party and Rashtriya Lok Dal demanded the repeal of the Labour Codes and reinstatement of the 44 labour Laws. The Morcha leaders held a Press Conference in Udaipur on Monday 14th December, 2021 and demanded the repeal of Labour Codes just as the Farm laws were repealed and demanded reinstatement of the 44 Labour Laws which they said were made after prolonged struggle by the working class. Addressing the Press Conference the state President of Janata Dal Secular Arjun Detha said that the Bihar Assembly has passed a unanimous resolution to demand caste based census. He said that the government of Rajasthan should also move a resolution to this effect and demand caste based census. He said that this will ensure proper representation of all the castes in jobs. Comrade Shankar Lal Chaudhary stressed the need to oppose privatization in the name of monetization. He said that if all public sectors is privatized there will be no meaning left in reservation policies.

CPIM leader S.R. Siddiqui demanded that employment should be the main focus. Government has sold out BSNL, Airports, Ports and is all set to sell out Railways. He demanded that this policy of privatization of public sector and Banks should immediately be stopped. CPI leader Himmat Chhangwal also demanded the repeal of Labour Codes and increase in the minimum wages of the labour all over, particularly in the state of Rajasthan where it is very low in comparison to Delhi and Kerala. The leaders said that they would launch a campaign to raise a struggle for these demands.

There is no foundation material in crochet work. In this artform, design is made with loop and interlink chain using the thread with hook to aid.

The Sustainable Future of Food In The Workplace

The catering industry is responding to an increased focus on food waste, wellbeing and sustainability. The challenge is to provide wholesome food that meets crucial corporate social responsibility targets, while answering consumer demand for nutrition.

We are all used to seeing an unseasonal array to produce practically everywhere we go to buy food. Now, there is a renewed focus on food supply chains across the world. Food prices are increasing globally, while food security is decreasing.



In order for cities and local governments to efficiently and effectively recycle food waste, actions taken at the household level or industrial level to separate it out are essential. Recycling schemes

only work when waste is properly sorted at the source. Judiciously used, regulations can spur households and businesses to reduce food waste and better manage it when it is time to recycle.

Rather than merely disposing of such waste in landfills, the use of bio gas plant to break it down into digestive, which can be used as fertilizer and biogas. Which can be used as an energy source or injected into the gas grid. Which is environmentally preferable to both composting and landfill disposal.

Where digestion is not possible, composting represents the best fall-back option. At the individual level, home composting can potentially divert up to 150 kg of food waste per household per year from local collection authorities.

Finally, incineration of food waste with the energy released being recovered presents the option of last resort for preventing food waste from ending up in landfills. Methane emissions from landfills represent one of the largest sources of GHG emissions from the waste sector. Processing, treating and disposing biodegradable waste through composting and bio Methanation is a part of Swatch Bharat Mission activities for Udaipur. Being a chef I am always thinking to reduce the food waste but 100% is not possible for this hotel industry. To utilize the wastage I have got a solution from Vaayu: A decentralised waste to energy solution for everyone. Vaayu is a bio-gas technology which will convert food waste to cooking gas (Methane). This is a completely biologically driven living process and it requires no running energy and it operates silently. A developed modular technology just like solar panels. This technology is human scale and can be easily operated by one person. The modularity makes the system robust as even if there is a problem in one module, it does not bring down the whole system. With this module from wastage we can generate cooking gas and fertilizer.

Modi had announced in his 2020 Independence Day address that the minimum age of marriage for girls in the country would be raised from 18 to 21. They do what they say, that is why after almost a year, and the Prime Minister has implemented his announcement. The Union Cabinet has approved a proposal to increase the legal age of marriage for women

from 18 to 21 years. Now it will be introduced in Parliament. Surely with the formation of this new system, a new light will come in the life of women. One destination, one direction and one way, yet there have been many inequalities in the life of man and woman, two forces of society were moving back and forth. To remove such discrepancies and inequalities, there was a knock on the door of thinking many times, whenever the door was opened, and the knocker appeared to return from there. But Modi also knocked and made it a reality, which should be welcome. Because with this, women will be able to see many discrepancies in their lives being removed while

developing rapidly. But the benefit of making a law is only when it is implemented in its entirety.

It is well known that the responsibility of a large number of girls' education, employment, and family management has been hampered due to marriage at an early age. After increasing the age of marriage, the Modi government will now introduce amendments to the Prohibition

of Child Marriage Act 2006 and consequently will bring amendments in personal laws such as the Special Marriage Act and the Hindu Marriage Act 1955. In December 2020, the recommendations were submitted to the NITI Aayog by the Task Force of the Centre headed by Jaya Jaitley.

This task force was set up to examine matters related to the age of motherhood, the imperative to reduce maternal mortality, and improve nutrition. On the basis of these recommendations, the Union Cabinet has approved the proposal to increase the marriage age of girls. The minimum age of marriage for girls is 21 years, there are many benefits, and the biggest advantage will be that the confidence and morale of the girls will increase. They remain useful. In passing, they have learned to wear beautiful clothes, to look beautiful and attractive, to decorate a beautiful house, to speak beautiful things of knowledge and science. For this it is necessary that they get freedom from the bondage and tradition of marriage at a young age.

There is no guarantee that they will be free from these customs and shackles even after the enactment of law. Even today, the laws made for the respect and rights of women in the country and the world are seen flying. A large section of the society still considers women to be of second status. Such orthodox thinking thinks that girls mature quickly, so the bride should be younger than the groom. At the same time, it is also said that since we have a patriarchal society, then when the husband grows up in age, his honour does not get hurt if the wife

obeys him.

But social workers and health experts have from time to time called for a rethinking of the marriage age of girls. After the year 1929, by amending the Sharda Act, in 1978, the age limit for marriage of women was increased from 15 to 18 years.

According to the World Health Organization, the maternal mortality rate is one lakh women die every year due to pregnancy due to its infectious causes. Younger marriages are the major cause of maternal mortality. That is why there has been a discussion on increasing the age of girls all over the world, changes are also being made. The minimum age of marriage in China is 22 years for men and 20 years for women.

In Pakistan and many other Muslim countries, the age of marriage is 18 years for men and 16 years for women. The minimum age for marriage of girls in Iran is 13 years, but girls are also married at the age of 9 if the court and the girl's father allow.

In Iraq, the age of marriage for girls is fixed at 18, but if the

parents allow, marriage can take place even at the age of 15.

Even in the US there is no upper limit. There were more than two lakh valid marriages of minors registered between 2000 and 2015. But it is a rich educated country with a different social structure, whereas India has a different social structure, here only by making laws and implementing them properly, ideal equality, co-living and development can be ensured. As India progresses, so too are opportunities for women to advance in education and career. Therefore, it is necessary to reduce the female mortality rate and improve the levels of nutrition.

While listening to the knock of time, it is necessary to look at the whole issue related to the age of a girl child with a sensitive point of view. Everyone should participate in shaping this new dream arising in the heart and mind of the structure of a healthy and egalitarian society, so that a new era of women's life-building can begin.

GMCH: An 88-year-old man beats his age by having a successful heart bypass surgery



Udaipur: It is generally seen that if someone has chest pain, any heart problem, or a heart attack, then the patient and his family get nervous. Often people are afraid of bypass surgery. When we go to the Higher Tertiary Centers where bypass surgeries, valve surgeries, children's operations, etc., are being done daily, it comes to know that the

risk in these types of procedures is significantly less. There is a belief among family people that the bypass operation of the heart is an open heart, which means that the heart has to be opened in it, whereas it is not at all. This is a closed heart operation.

In Geetanjali Medical College and Hospital, Cardiac Sciences' experienced Cardiac

Surgeons, Cardiac Anesthetists, Cardiologists, Perfusionists, ICU, OT staff are continuously performing such complex operations for the last ten years. Due to the relentless efforts of the cardiac team, the 88-year-old was successfully treated, and he was given a new life.

Cardiac surgeon, Dr. Sanjay Gandhi, said that if any

old heart patient wants to live well in walking, he can get the operation done, and bypass surgery is as easy for him as it is for a young man. When any heart patient is living with trouble with blockage of the pulse, it is better to live well by getting proper treatment or surgery if required, which can increase both the quality of life and the life of the patient. Bypass operation is performed by making a small incision on the beating heart (beating heart surgery); bypass surgery is carried out without opening the soul; in this, the patient is also less pained, and the recovery is very quick. Heart Lung Machine is not even used in this type of operation; a similar issue was seen in the Department of Cardiac Sciences of Geetanjali Hospital in an 88-year-old old man.

This old retired civil engineer. patient for a long time.

He was finding it difficult to carry out his routine tasks. The patient was also treated with medicines but without any success in such a situation. Angiography of the patient was done in which there was 90% blockage in the left main pulse of the patient's heart, and there was a lot of blockage in the remaining three veins and 100% blockage in the right artery. The patient's beating heart underwent bypass surgery, in which four bypass pulses were installed. The patient was discharged from the hospital on the 5th day. The patient is still healthy, able to eat and walk.

The biggest challenge in the treatment of the patient was the fear of the society and not the operation of the patient, the

patient and his family wanted to get the operation done, the patient's family members are cardiac surgeons in America, the patient's family also consulted them and brought the patient to Geetanjali Hospital. Gaya! It is necessary to change this kind of thinking of society in today's context.

Giving information, Dr. Gandhi said that now there is no fear in heart disease and its treatment, today with the advent of new technologies, the risk of operation has reduced a lot. 2-3 bypass operations are being done daily in Geetanjali Hospital. Successful "Awake Brain Surgery" in PMCH

Udaipur: Sonu, 36, who worked as a security guard in a private company in Udaipur, underwent complex brain tumor surgery while conscious in PMCH. During this, a unique confluence of science and faith was seen. The patient kept talking with the doctor during the surgery while playing the Garuda Gandhi. This surgery was supported by the team of neurosurgeon Dr. Narendra Mal, Dr. Naveen Sethia, neuro intensivist Dr. Ramakant, Dr. Ganesh Gupta, Deepak Chaturvedi, Sunil Jain, and Pankaj Beas.

The patient has been facing problems for the last two years due to complaints of headaches and dizziness. Relatives told that in the previous five months, the patient was shown to neurosurgeon Dr. Narendra Mal in PMCH due to complaints of persistent headache, dizziness, and blurred vision in front of the eyes.

Neurosurgeon Dr. Narendra Mal said that after doing an MRI of the patient, it was found that a tumor was detected in the left side of the patient's brain, which was curable only by operation.

Dr. Mal said that this operation was hazardous

as speech and memory loss were risks during the procedure. After talking to the patient's relatives, it was decided to do the patient's wake surgery and successfully remove the brain tumor and give new life to the patient.

Dr. Narendra Mal said that the high-end microscope was used in this four-hour surgery, which could help to see the brain area closely. Such surgeries can be performed only at select centers in the country that require an experienced neurosurgical team available at PMCH.

Neurosurgeon Dr. Narendramal explained that such a unique neurosurgical procedure performed in the awake state of the patient is called Awake Craniotomy or Awake Brain Surgery. Its purpose is to keep the patients conscious and manipulate only those tissues that are completely dead. By being mindful of the patient, the doctor keeps knowledge about the living tissue so that the living tissue is least harmed. This is a difficult process in which doctors try to keep the patient inaction by engaging the patient and giving him some work.

Neuro-intrusive Dr. Ramakant said that the latest technique called Awake Craniotomy or Awake Brain Surgery is in vogue worldwide to remove the tumor from the part of the brain that controls the sight speech or main movements of the body. In this case, the cancer was


in the amount of the brain that controls speech and the main body's activities. This surgery was also challenging because even a tiny mistake during the surgery could result in the patient losing the ability to speak.

Brain tumor removed with the laparoscope

Udaipur: A brain tumor was removed from the laparoscope at GBH American Hospital.

Due to this type of complex operation being done with the help of a laparoscope, the patient does not have to stay in the hospital for long, and there is no bleeding during the operation.
