Not only this, there were efforts to bring back the economic growth rate, but it will take a long time to heal the wound of the epidemic and defeat Omicron. In the last year, we have been forced to drink bitter sips of economic imbalance. During this, the gap of economic

inequality in India widened further. In India, 57 per cent of the country's total income went into the pockets of the top 10 per cent. Half of the population earned only 13 percent. Efforts made in the past to eradicate the poverty line, have again engulfed the blind den of poverty. The poor countries of the world will have to fight for self-reliance very fast. The coming years are sure to be of economic nationalism.

Now, not ignoring the threat of Omicron, both the government and society have geared up to deal with it, but when the results will come, how many will come, no one has any guarantee. With the beginning of the construction of Shri Ram temple in Ayodhya last year, the inauguration of Vishwanath Dham complex in Varanasi this month can be said to be a special initiative to give a new dimension and vision to the political thinking of India. 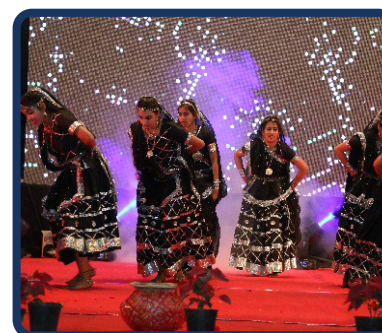
