The Minister addressed the problems faced by the indusin the supply of electricity to the Managing Director of A.V.V.N.L., Shri VS. Bhati. By talking to me on the mobile phone, this problem was resolved immediately.

Taking cognizance of the entrepreneurs' power-related problems, the Minister directed to hold a one-day discussion meeting in which high officials of the A.V.V.N.L. department would also be present.

Vice President Shri Vijay Godha drew the attention of the Minister to the difficulties being faced in the marble business and requested proper disposal.Shri Ashish Chhabra and Shri Manish Galundia of the Tourism Committee requested to give hotels industry status and charge electricity charges at industrial rates.

Mr. G.S. Sisodia said that U.C.C.I. has set up joint ventures with entrepreneurs of the Udaipur division on the industrial land available with them other than industries if an investor is willing. With this, the government will get additional revenue, and the government will not have to spend on basic industrial facilities. New employment opportunities will be available in this tribaldominated area. The government should decide on this subject and implement this suggestion

Revenue Minister of Rajasthan Government, Shri Ramlal Jat, while praising the work being done by U.C.C.I. for the industrial development of the division, said that there are immense possibilities of setting up new industries in the Udaipur division and the state government is making full efforts to attract investment here. Removed the rib that is pressing on the veins

Udaipur: Physicians at Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences P.I.M.S.) Hospital Umrda has provided relief to the patient by successfully performing a complex surgery to remove the rib that is pressing on the nerves.

Chairman Asheesh Agarwal said that the seventeen-yearold Devika had an extra rib in her neck since birth. This rib was pressing on the main artery of blood going from the neck to the arm and the brachial plexus veins. This caused unbearable pain in the left hand of the patient. After the investigations have been done here, writing and microvascular surgeon Dr. Yogeshkumar Sharma obliterated the pressure from the veins by doing excision in the cervical rib.
