73rd Republic Day Celebrations



Republic Day celebrated with simplicity in Udaipur

Udaipur: 73rd Republic Day was celebrated with enthusiasm and simplicity at Gandhi Ground on Wednesday. On this occasion, the Chief Guest, Food and Civil Supplies, and Consumer Affairs Minister Pratap Singh Khachariyawas unfurled the national flag and inspected the parade.

Minister Khachariyawas, while wishing the Republic Day, said that the country is standing as a significant force in the world today; the only reason for this is that people of all classes, Hindus, Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, are one and all have the same resolve.
