Coconut tree water conservation

In the camp of National Service Scheme on Water Conservation, which was held in the workshop of College of Dairy Food Technology, Dr. P.C. Jain asked how water can be saved throughout the day, for this, that there is a change in our water-spending habits—not running timing tap, proper use of RO system, etc. We can save water regularly and save it from wastage by doing this, like using soap instead of shampoo, cleaning utensils with lemon ash soap instead of liquid detergent, cleaning vehicles with a wet cloth, and brushing shaving.

TDSCheck App - By checking the TDS of water brought by the students, he said that 300 to 400 is the best, and the wastewater of RO can be used in a latrine.



Jal-Chalisa-Volunteers together decided to give the message of water conservation in the society by singing Jal Chalisa and saving the water from the coming rain.

Jal-Aarti - Three students sang the water-god Indradev's aarti from the plate of worship, worshiped, and gave the message of water conservation to everyone throughout their life.

Save coconut water-After this, the volunteers spread coconut shells all around under the Ashoka tree. Then, pouring water in it gave the message that this water will keep going to its roots for a long time and will not evaporate away need for water is

Because coconut will hold water in itself, this experiment should also be done in its pots so that water does not have to be watered daily - said the water hero, Dr. P.C. Jain.

Saw-Rain Water Harvesting Plant-After this, Dr. Jain showed them the rooftop rainwater harvesting system installed behind the college building. He said that this is the cheapest simple system; in this, the rainwater falling on the roof, which fails, is connected and then connected to a filter attached to borewell, hand pump well, etc., during the rainy season. Keeps getting recharged vesselsIncreases Quantity, Quality - It also increases the quantity and quality of groundwater, and the chemicals which harm our bodies are controlled.
