Udaipur: Panchkalyanak Pratishtha Mahotsav of Shri 1008 Adinath Digambar Jain Temple will be organized in Hiran Magri Sector 4 from 6th to 10th April 2022. Acharya Shri Sunil Sagar Maharaj's grand entrance on Sunday regarding the prestige festival. A press conference was organized on the temple premises on Tuesday regarding this Panchkalyanak festival to be organized by Shri Digambar Jain Dasha Human Samaj Sanstha in collaboration with Sakal Jain Samaj.



Giving information about the programs, the President of Pratishtha Mahotsav Committee, Kamal Kumar Jain, said that on April 6, the festival would be inaugurated by

Acharya Shri Sunil Sagar Maharaj Sangha with flag hoisting and Garbh Kalyanak, grand Ghat Yatra procession. In which hundreds of men and women will participate. Four horses, two Elephants, and thirty carriages will be glorified in the march by the Indra family and the unique family.

The procession will start from Sector 4 temple and will reach the Ayodhya city pandal built-in Swayamvar Vatika, the place of the Panchkalyanak program, where the pandal will be inaugurated by Shanti Lal Velavat, President of Sakal Digambar Jain Samaj in the presence of Acharya Shri. Along with this, religious events like flag hoisting, Pandal Shuddhi, Mandap Shuddhi, etc., will occur. Along with this, the Shravak-Shravikas will also benefit from the good discourses of Acharya Shri. On this day, the mother's baby shower, grand Mangal Aarti in the evening, the theatrical form of Garbha Kalyanak in the night, and the city of Ayodhya will be created.

On the second day of the festival, the birth of a Tirthankar child will take place in Kalyanak. In a grand Janabhishek procession, along with 1008 urns, the Tirthankar boy will be consecrated on Pandushila by Soudharma Indra. Pandushila has been composed in the community center of Hiran Magri Sector 4.

Welcome President Jai Kumar Jain told that on the third day of the festival, an auspicious beginning would be made on the penance Kalyanak with religious activities like daily worship, Abhishek, Shantidhara, etc. The main centers of the festival will be child play of Tirthankar boy, the arrival of 32000 crowned kings, coronation, Niranjana dance, Vairagya Darshan, initiation, and welfare ceremony.

Construction head Anil Kumar Joshi said that on the fourth day of the festival, only after the morning worship in Gyan Kalyanak there will be food for Tirthankar Mahamuni Raj. A grand harmony will be created. In order to make God from a special stone, an opening ceremony, Suri mantra, praise, and only knowledge worship will be done. The last day of the Pratishtha Mahotsav will be celebrated on April 10 as the salvation of the Lord. God's salvation will go. Along with this, a grand procession will be taken out after the auspicious discourse of Acharya Shri. The iconic idols will be placed in the temple, and the Kalash and the flag on the summit will be decorated with chants.
