**P**rim Minister Narendra Modi today said that the 'Yes, we can do it' attitude of the sports persons has become the new strength of India.

The Prime Minister said this while interacting with the Indian men's badminton team who scripted history by winning the Thomas Cup and the women's team of the Uber Cup. Mr Modi lauded the Indian team, of Lakshya Sen, Kidambi Srikanth, HS Prannoy, doubles

pair Satwiksairaj Rankireddy-Chirag Shetty for winning the first ever Thomas Cup for India. The Prime Minister mentioned that this team has infused tremendous energy in the country by winning the Thomas cup and a long wait of seven decades finally came to an end. He added that whosoever knows Badminton, must have dreamt of this feat and it has been realized by this team. Mr Modi said that such successes inject great ener-

gy and confidence in the entire sporting ecosystem of the country and this victory has done something that cannot be accomplished by greatest of the coaches or the powerful oratory of the leaders. The players also expressed gratitude to the country and the Prime Minister for the motivation and said that they were determined to win the medal during the finals. HS Prannoy said, it has been a happy moment for all as the Thomas Cup has been



won for the first time in 73 yrs. 14-year old Unnati Hooda said that the favourite thing about PM Modi is that he never differentiates between a medalist and a non-medalist and celebrated the achievements in sports.

Kidambi Srikanth said players will always be proud to say that they have the backing of the Prime Minister. He said, this is unmatched and will motivate all players to do well. Last Sunday, India Men's

badminton team won the Thomas Cup title for the first time in 73 years with a stunning 3-0 win over powerhouse Indonesia in the final. Prime Minister Modi had a telephonic conversation with the Indian team, immediately after they emerged victorious in the final.

Indian men reached the Thomas Cup semi-finals in 1952, 1955 and 1979 while the women's team made it to the Uber Cup top-four in 2014 and 2016.

## The Union Government has reduced the Central excise duty on Petrol and on Diesel

The Union Government has reduced the Central excise duty on Petrol by eight rupees per litre and on Diesel by six rupees per litre. This will reduce the price of petrol by nine rupees 50 paise per litre and of Diesel by seven rupees per litre. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman announced this in a series of tweets yesterday.

The Minister said, it will have revenue implication of around 1 lakh crore rupees per year for the Government. She exhorted all State governments, especially the States where reduction was not done during the last round in November last year, to also implement a similar cut and give relief to the common man.

Ms Sitharaman also announced that this year, the Government will give a subsidy of 200 rupees per gas cylinder upto 12 cylinders to over 9 crore beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana. This will have a revenue implication of around 6100 crore rupees a year.

The Government is also reducing the customs duty on raw materials and intermediaries for plastic prod-



ucts where the country's import dependence is high. This will result in reduction of cost of final products.

The Minister said similarly, customs duty is being calibrated on raw materials and intermediaries for iron and steel to reduce their prices. Import duty on some raw materials of steel will be reduced.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said that finan-

cial decisions, especially the one relating to the significant drop in petrol and diesel prices will positively impact various sectors. In a tweet, Mr Modi said, it will provide relief to our citizens and further 'Ease of Living'.

Home Minister Amit Shah has said that even in this challenging global situation, the Central Government under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi has provided a huge relief to the common people.

BJP President J P Nadda has lauded the Government's decision to slash the excise duty on petrol and diesel. He said, it shows Prime Minister Narendra Modi's commitment to the welfare of the common man.

Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said, the Central excise duty cut on Petrol and Diesel is a major step towards easing prices.

Confederation of All India Traders Secretary General Praveen Khandelwal said, with the reduction in fuel prices the transportation cost will come down.

## Spinning Wheel LEADERSHIP FOUNDATION

**Udaipur:** India: Why do teachers need to be leaders and problem solvers in everyday life? It is with this thought that the 2-Day Young Leaders' Basecamp kicked off at the District Institute of Education and training, Udaipur on Monday. The event is a curated leadership and capacity-building workshop and



pitch competition designed by Udaipur-based non-profit Spinning Wheel Leadership Foundation and USA-based Watson Institute. The event saw participation from close to 50 trainee teachers who engaged in sessions aimed at building their skills as changemakers and lead-

ers. The event saw Masterclass sessions from two invited guests. Erika Abrams, the founder of Animal Aid India, one of the largest animal hospitals and rescue facilities, spoke to the participants about her journey as an social entrepreneur and the various personal and professional ups and downs one faces in the journey and how to stay balanced and in control of oneself through it all.

The founder of Jai Bhim Vikas Shikshan Sangathan, Ms. Premalata Rathore also motivated the young audience. She spoke about her journey working in the complex space of caste, human rights and labor, especially as an upper caste woman working primarily from people coming from marginalized caste backgrounds.

All participants were divided into teams, aptly named after some of the pioneers of education - Savitribai Phule, Fatima Sheikh, B.R. Ambedkar, etc. Each team has now been assigned a problem related to education and development in

this country. Examples of some of these problems include menstrual hygiene for adolescent girls, substance abuse among young people, infrastructural challenges in school, etc. Day 2 of the event (Tuesday, 17th May) will see participants receive some intensive training on design thinking, problem-solving, and communication, that will help each team design innovative solutions to these extremely important challenges. The teams will also participate in a pitch competition that will be judged by experts from the field of education and social development.

This event is organized and conducted by the Spinning Wheel Leadership Foundation. Since 2017, SWLF has worked with over 7000 students from rural and tribal backgrounds, to provide them with life skills that are crucial to succeed in the 21st century, but often don't reach students from these remote backgrounds. Along with students, SWLF also works to enhance the capacity of teachers, to better equip

them to prepare young people for a life of success and upward mobility. Sanjivani Singh, co-founder of spinning Wheel Leadership Foundation said "these trainee teachers are going to be entering classrooms very soon, and shaping the lives of thousands of children in the coming years."

Thus working on their capacity building and equipping them to become leaders who can deal with challenges is essential. Only if they have these skills and confidence can they inculcate them into their teaching and pass them on to the future generations."

The event is conducted in partnership with DIET, which is the agency primarily responsible for teacher training in the district. The program and curriculum have been designed alongside a USA-based institution

called the Watson Institute and is supported by the Western Union Foundation. All these actors reunited in their common desire to prepare the youth to be the leaders of tomorrow.
