



Congress workers will not tolerate the anti-youth Agnipath scheme, and the central government will have to withdraw - Dangi

Bhilwara (Pawan Garg): On Monday, the BJP (NDA) government's plan of recruitment in the country's Army through the Agnipath scheme as anti-youth and anti-national, Congress at the information center square in Bhilwara on the instructions of AICCC and State Congress Committee (PCC). Satyagraha was held under the leadership of former District President of Bhilwara and Congress candidate from Bhilwara Assembly Constituency Anil Dangi.

Many party functionaries and workers, including Bhilwara Assembly Coordinator CM Bhadala, participated in the Satyagraha carried out as per the instructions of Congress leader Rahul Gandhi. The worker was sitting with placards written in protest against the Agnipath scheme of the central government.

Some students were also



attracting attention by being present at the Satyagraha site wearing army costumes. These students were demanding immediate withdrawal of the Agnipath scheme as anti-youth.

12-year-old Tanishq got relief from aneurysmal bone cyst (ABC) disease

Udaipur: In the Pacific Medical College and Hospital Bedla, a 12-year-old boy was successfully operated on for an aneurysmal bone cyst (ABC) and got relief from this disease. The successful operation was supported by the orthopedic surgeon Dr. Ashish Batra, Dr. Prakash Audichya, Dr. Vikram, Dr. Harsh, Dr. Abhilash, Dr. Devarajan, Dr. Rahul, and Subhash.

12-year-old Tanishq, a resident of Daulpura of Devgarh tehsil of Rajasamand district, has been facing problems for the last six months due to the pain of lump and swelling in the feet. The relatives showed many places but did not get any benefit. The family brought him to the Pacific Hospital Bedla, where he delivered him to orthopedic surgeon Dr. Ashish Batra, then on investigations.

He found a lump of cancer in the fibula, which was possible to treat only by operation.

Dr. Ashish Batra explained that an aneurysmal bone cyst is a highly destructive benign bone tumor, occurring in less than 1 in 100,000 people annually. ABCs usually appear in a person within 20 years of birth, with the most common locations being the hands (humerus), legs (tibia, fibula, femur), pelvis, and spine. In which about 15 to 20 percent is in the spinal cord.

Dr. Batra explained that aneurysmal bone cysts result from the crisscrossing of small portions of chromosomes 16 and 17, resulting in the formation of highly malignant tumor tissue, in which chromosomal translocation activates an oncogene a tumor-causing gene. The child is now completely healthy and has been discharged. The patient's relatives thanked the chairman Rahul Agarwal, the doctors, nursing staff and management for the free treatment and better medical facilities.

Sajjan Katara did a surprise inspection at Community Health Center in Tidi

Reverse solder replacement prevented shoulder dislocation

Udaipur (Dr Munesha arora): The patient's frequent shoulder pain was relieved by joint replacement and reverse solder replacement in the Orthoscopic Department of GBH General Hospital. According to the surgeon, this type of operation has been selective.

Jagdishchandra (65), a resident of Gujarat, used to have frequent shoulder fall, which he got operated on in Ahmedabad, but after a few days, this complaint started again. On this, the family reached out to see Dr. Suryakant Purohit, Joint Replacement and Orthoscopic Surgeon of GBH General Hospital. Here, MRI and other tests found that all the ligaments running the shoulder were torn. Because of this, the complaint persisted. The only option was reverse solder replacement. On this, a team of Dr. Prashant Gupta, Dr. Anil Patel, and Dr. Piyush Garg from the Department of Anesthesia was formed under the leadership of Dr. Suryakant Purohit. He prepared the joint upside down in the reverse solder replacement technique. Instead of the ball of the shoulder, a cup was put in place of the ball and a ball was put in place of the cup. It does not require a ligament, and the shoulder starts working as before. After a complicated surgery that lasted about three hours, the patient returned home after recovering completely. Dr. Suryakant Purohit claims that this operation has been done selectively in the Udaipur division.
