



Media workshop organized in Bhilwara Press Club

District Collector Ashish Modi emphasized keeping positivity in mind and publishing factual news in the era of fast media. The pace of development will increase only when the right things come in front of the public. The position of media today cannot be denied. The District Collector said that the words might be few, but their essence should be very high. The computer is the time for social networking. Today people have less time.

For this reason, the art of putting more and more things in front of you in fewer words, that is, quality work, should be done with quantity. By understanding the quality and chang-

ing the technology, you can express your point in fewer words. Let the figures be actual because even a message sent to a person sitting in the neighborhood first comes to America, Delhi, then Ajmer comes to you.

Describing the role of journalism in the 21st century, Superintendent of Police Adarsh Siddhu said that credibility is maintained by having authenticity in the news.

Mukesh Meena, Chairman of Pink City Press Club Jaipur, said there is a demand for fact-based news in public today. Pinkcity Press Club also organizes such seminars from time to time. He said that talks are going on with the state government regarding the problems of journalists. The policy is going to come out soon.

Senior journalist Dayaram Methani said there is a differ-

ence between today and earlier journalism. Today, despite the abundance of facilities, reliability is needed. Methani noted that the biggest strength of media is credibility. Ink, paper, not words, data is the most crucial thing that increases trust and likes in the news. Chairman Rakesh Pathak said its genuine journalists' responsibility to check fake journalism.

Welcoming everyone, Press Club President Sukhpal Jat said that today there is a need for this type of workshop in the media. That's why it has been done and will be done in the future. Keeping in view the Press Club's problems and journalists' problems, he requested the Revenue Minister to intervene from the Government.

Club Vice-President Moolchand Peswani, who is

conducting the forum, informed about the Press Club's activities and kept the journalists' problems. In the end, General Secretary Rajesh Methani, while highlighting the importance of data, said that their role in the news would remain significant. Earlier, the program started with lamp lighting on the picture of Maa Saraswati.

Essential role of use of data and graphics

Deepti Soni, Senior Consultant, ISB, said that data and graphics could play an important role in making the news factual and reliable. After the changing environment in newspapers, data and statistics have increased the credibility of the information. The words which a thousand cannot speak can be easily explained through figures and graphics.

Giving information about the India Data Portal, he said that the Landscape Survey was started in 2020. Journalists and students engaged in research were having trouble with the data. There was no news related to farming and corporate. The information that was coming had quality, but the numbers were not. Figures that can be trusted. The India Data Portal was the first to prepare data on agriculture, financial inclusion and rural development. Today, there are data

on India Data Portal from covid to Tehsil of every region to state and country to the world. These have to be taken in different fibers or can be taken in graphics.

India Data Portal will now get a lot of support in the news. There are 80 types of data that have been prepared in two years. Central and Prime Minister's schemes, which state got how much budget, how much was spent, the data of rainfall, assembly and Lok Sabha is also being prepared. The team has also updated all these on the portal.

There was a situation of migration during covid. It was revealed in the data that the maximum number of people joined MNREGA. A budget of up to one thousand crores went to Covid. But now, after the situation improves, that graph is rapidly coming down.

Deepti Soni gave detailed information on how to get information from the portal.

ISB consultant Upendra Singh said that about two years back, it had come to the fore that journalists were not getting data about the news. This causes a lot of trouble. A survey was conducted regarding this. A whole team worked day and night for almost two years, and then these figures came out. Today these figures are proving to be helpful for everyone in every field.
