



Udaipur-Ahmedabad train likely to run from next month

Barisadri-Udaipur train will run from this month

New Delhi: Chittorgarh MP CP Joshi met Union Minister of Railways, Communications, Information and Technology Ashwini Vaishnav and Railway Board Chairman Vinay Kumar Tripathi in New Delhi on Friday.

During this meeting, MP Joshi discussed the preparation of a new gauge converting line Mavli-Brisadri of the parliamentary constituency. On this route, it is proposed to run a passenger train from



Badisadri to Udaipur via Mavli. It was informed that preparations have been made to start passenger train on this route this month, which will provide

better transportation facilities to the area's residents.

MP Joshi said that this train will leave Barisadri at around 6-7 am, reach Udaipur at about

9 am and leave Udaipur in the evening to reach Barisadri by night, reaching thousands of Mavli, Vallabhnagar, Bhinder, Kanod, Dungala, Barisadri

tehsils. People of families will be able to get convenient and cheap means to come to Udaipur daily; currently, people of this area are living in a rented city; due to the running of this car, they will be able to live with their family.

Rail service on Udaipur Ahmedabad broad gauge from next month

Similarly, there is a proposal to run passenger trains on Mewar's much-awaited Udaipur-Ahmedabad gauge conversion line in the coming month. Presently, the work of this route is almost complete, and the final CRS has been completed. Inspection is also to be done soon, after which

this route will also be ready for running the train. Railway Minister has assured to run trains on this route in the coming month.

Along with this, the work of electrification on the broad gauge line of Mavli-Barisadri and Udaipur-Ahmedabad is also in progress.

Member of Parliament Joshi urged the Railway Minister to run Ahmedabad-Udaipur rail up to Kota so that by running daily trains between Kota and Ahmedabad on this route, convenient trains will be available to the residents of Chittorgarh and Udaipur to reach Ahmedabad and Kota.

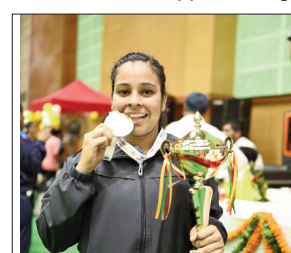
