

Industry-Academic Meet @Sangam University

This time on Sunday, from 3 pm to 7:15 pm, a special darshan of Chhappan Bhog was held at Charbhuj Nath Bada Mandir with Khatu Shyam standing; the tableau of Khatu Shyam was the center of unique attraction.

Mahaveer Samdani, in charge of Trust Media, said that the historic Segari Chhappan Bhog was performed for the first time by various devotees of Charbhuj Nath at 7:15 am. Maha Aarti followed by distribution of prasad was performed before Charbhuj Nath's milk consecration at 5:30 am. At 11:00 am, the flag of Charbhuj Nath was offered by priest Bhima Shankar Pradeep Parashar, who said that for the first time, the segari Chhappan bhog was installed by the devotees in which 56 types of Segari dishes including Singhada ki dana, Singhada ki namkeen, Singhada aloo vada, barfi, shrikhand, dhania ki panjeri, segari gulab jamun, various kinds of seasonal fruits, dry fruits, saffron peda, sago khichdi, sava phulera, aloo ki chips, wafers, 56 types of Segari dishes including Chivda, Milk Cake, Badam Katli, Cashew Rolls are offered to Lord Charbhuj Nath by offering Chhappan Bhog to Lord Charbhuj Nath in a unique way and collected in 115 thalis. Bhilwara: The All India Mahasabha open session was held in Samelia Mandir Dham. The Mahatmas came from every corner of the country of Vishnoi society, and officials and public representatives of social organizations participated.

In the program to be organized on the holy festival of Gurupurnima, in the presence of Saint Bhagwan Prakash of Bhilwara Mahasabha and Samelia Vikas Seva Samiti, Pithadhiswar respected Ramanand Ji Maharaj of Salasar Saathi, Mahant of Shri Sachidanand Ji and Garima Mayi Saints of the place was completed in the presence of Saints.

President of Samelia Development Institute and Bhilwara District (Vishnoi Samaj) Shri Amarchand Bishnoi told in the welcome address that behind Samelia Dham, Rana Sanga of Mewar, the immediate king of Mewar, built a temple to Bilhoji's disciple Agnanddas Ji Maharaj, two stepwells, 200 bighas of land including Surajpol.
