AKSHAYA SABAL Yojana, doctors, should also adopt patients - CMHO

Udaipur: The meeting of the District Health Committee was held today in the Zilla Parishad auditorium to review the various schemes and programs run by the Medical and Health Department. In the meeting, Chief Medical and Health Officer Dr. Dinesh Kharadi discussed the block-wise target and achievement of the programs run by the department after interacting with the Block Chief Medical Officers.

Chief Medical and Health Officer, Dr. Ragini Agrawal, Family Welfare, RCHO Dr. Ashok Aditya, Maternal and Child Health, DPC RMSC Dr. Mohan Dhakad presented the progress report on the free medicine and investigation scheme through the presentation, on which CMHO asked about low achievement institutions. Were summoned in this regard

Make special efforts for the eradication of TB

In the meeting, while discussing tuberculosis elimination with the members of the TB form, DTO Dr. Anshul Matha apprised the tuberculosis patients about the nutritional needs during treatment under the NIKSHAYA SABAL scheme. He said that any Bhamashah could join this scheme and provide nutritious food during six months of treatment.

Taking an exemplary initiative, Add. CMHO Dr. Ragini Agarwal started adopting five patients. she said that if all the doctors of the district assume even one tuberculosis patient, then their nutritional needs can be met to a great extent.

In the meeting, it was suggested to connect private hospitals and testing centers with free TB tests to increase further TB patients' testing facilities. CMHO Dr. Kharadi directed the District Tuberculosis Officer to private hospitals and testing centers with True Not machines available—required to get the MoU done by the department so that free TB tests can be made available to the patients at private centers also.

Review of seasonal diseases and healthy liver campaign - In the meeting, a review was also held regarding the Healthy Liver campaign operating in the district. Deputy CMHO Dr. Raghavendra Rai said that all the BCMOs should ensure that the water tanks and other drinking water sources are purified by coordinating with the drinking water department in their area of work, as per the action plan, as well as hepatitis B test of pregnant mothers, hepatitis B of children. To give wide publicity. To the campaign, including vaccination.

Because of the possibility of increasing seasonal diseases during the rainy season, special attention was directed to the slides of fever patients, spraying of pyrethrum in the field, etc.

Connect admitted patients to Chiranjeevi Yojana

While reviewing the Chief Minister Chiranjeevi Health Insurance Scheme, CMHO Dr. Kharadi expressed displeasure over the number of patients admitted under the Chiranjeevi Yojana at the community health centers. He said that each CHC-in-charge should appoint a nodal officer in his hospital to ensure that the patients admitted to the hospital are connected with the Chiranjeevi Yojana.

Dr. Kharadi was also directed to complete the survey to connect the deprived families in the district at the earliest.

Means of family welfare should be available till the sub-health center

While reviewing the family welfare program, Add. CMHO Family Welfare Dr. Ragini Agrawal said that many sub-health centers are not demanding online family planning, which is improper. While directing all the BCMOs, he said, banning ASHA and ANMs, they should send demand from all the sub-health centers before July 31.

In the meeting, CMHO notified BPM and BNO of the low achievement block in PPIUCD and Antara Raj and directed them to call for answers.

Representatives of development partners, including DPM Sadaqat Ahmed, DPC Chiranjeevi Sharad Patidar, all Block Chief Medical Officers, CHC in-charge, BPM, and BNO, were present in this meeting held in the Zilla Parishad auditorium.

Saashan Shri Muni Harsh Lal Ji Swami wrote the essence of the entire Gita

Bhilwara: Muni Shri Anand Kumar Ji Kalu told that Muni Shri Harshal Ji Swami, a disciple of Acharya Tulsi, wrote about 700 hundred verses of all the 18 chapters of Shrimad Bhagwat Geeta on both sides on 9 inches long and 4.5 inches wide paper. In this, Shrimad Bhagwat Geeta Jain Aagam Dashvaika Link and Sanskrit Poetry Sambodhi are prominent. These include twenty thousand verses, including Abhidhan Chintamani Kosh Kalu Komudi. Muni Harsh Lal Ji, a resident of Lachuda village of Mandal subdivision area, told Bhaskar that it was his hobby to write a book subtly. As a child, he took initiation in Sardarshahar in front of Acharya Shri Tulsi.

Now stopped writing

Writing in small letters is no longer possible for Muni Harsh Lalji in old age. He says that when writing subtle texts, even the help of glasses was not used. Now the light of the eyes has also become very weak.

In the course prescribed by Acharya Tulsi, self-study is prominent in various religious texts. Apart from Jain texts, many texts, including Gita, Upanishad, etc.
