Revenue Minister inaugurated 33 KV GSS in Mandal

Bhilwara: During a visit to Bhilwara, Revenue Minister Shri Ramlal Jat inaugurated 33 KV GSS in his assembly constituency, Mandal.

With the installation of this grid constructed at the cost of 90 lakhs, the people of the area will not face the problems related to a power supply.



Revenue Minister Shri Ramlal Jat, while addressing the people present during the inauguration program in Mandal, said that on the demand of the people of the area, this electricity grid had been made separately for Mandal. Also, it is the first such Gram Panchayat in the state where underground lines of electric cables have been laid. Hanging wires will no longer be seen on the streets, neighborhoods, and roofs of houses, and electrical accidents will also not occur.

Shri Jat said that laying underground lines of electric cables in the Mandal area has almost been completed. Earlier it was such a situation that people could not even open the windows of two-story houses due to fear of electric wires, and there was a possibility of accidents. With the help of the state government, we have the electric wires underground in such a situation. Transformers have been installed at different places in Mandal town, due to which the electricity problem in Mandal town has ended, and there will be no more voltage problem in the city, homes will get full voltage.

The Revenue Minister said that the State Government made nine grids of 132 KV and 87 grids of 33 KV in the district. In the Mandal assembly constituency, 16 grids were made by the government in the last term, and eight grids have been built during this tenure. In Mandal, the electricity grid of 33 KV will provide electricity to small industries and houses here. Excellent work on the power supply was done in the entire assembly constituency, including Mandal.

Shri Jat said that the State Government had given a splendid budget for electricity in its budget. He said that the State Government had started schemes like free treatment and free electricity up to 50 units to increase the savings of the state's families. Apart from this, various discounts are being given by the government on electricity bills above 50 units. The government is waiving the electricity bills of the cultivating farmers.

He said that under the leadership of Chief Minister Shri Ashok Gehlot, the State Government is providing free treatment up to Rs. 10 lakh to the entire family through Chiranjeevi Swasthya Bima Yojana. He said that such a facility is not available in any other state of the country. Also, the upcoming budget will be an employment-oriented budget for the state's youth.

According to the intention of Chief Minister Shri Ashok Gehlot, lakhs of people will benefit from savings due to a reduction in electricity bills, free testing, and treatment. He said that with the money saved on free treatment and electricity bills, the poor, farmers, and laborers should spend on educating their children, which will bring awareness to them.

DISCOM's Superintending Engineer Shri Shishram Verma informed that 33/11 GSS had been constructed to keep the electricity system in Mandal village completely smooth. Five feeders of 11 KV Bhilwara Road, Beawar Road, Meja Road/Chand Bagh, Dhowani Nadi, and Balai Kheda (Agriculture) have been made.

Earlier, the village's electricity supply was from Meja and Mandal intersection. There are 4600 electricity connections in the entire town. At any time, the electricity of the whole village had to be switched off for redressal of line faults and other complaints, but now it will not happen when GSS is started. 3 km 11 KV and 15 km LT have been grounded through UIT at about six crores. Six new transformers have been installed in Mandal village.

During this, various public representatives and officials, including Mandal Pradhan Shri Shankar Kumawat, Sarpanch Shri Sanjay Bhandia, Sub-Divisional Officer Dr. Pooja Saxena, Discom Chief Engineer Shri ML Meena, were present.
