## Reconstructed 16-year-old's genitalia in PMCH

**Udaipur:** At Pacific Medical College and Hospital, a 16-year-old girl's genitalia were reconstructed, and she was given the right to live like an ordinary woman. A rare case of absence of menstruation was reported in this teenager. She was shown many places but to no avail. But the treatment was done by reconstructing the vagina of the girl through a unique surgery by a team of doctors from Pacific Hospital.

The 16-year-old girl was troubled due to the problem of stomach pain for the last four years. If the girl's parents had shown her to the local doctor, she would have gotten some relief, but the problem would start again as soon as menstruation came.

The family brought her to the Pacific Hospital, where they showed her to Pediatric Surgeon Dr. Praveen Jhanwar; on examination, it was found that her genitalia were not formed since birth, and the path of the uterus was also closed, due to which every month's menstrual blood comes to her. The uterus was gathering, and the pain in her abdomen increased continuously. After examining the child thoroughly, she was advised for an operation.

Pediatric surgeon Dr. Praveen Jhanwar, Plastic surgeon Dr. Gurubhushan, Dr. Prakash Audichya of the Department of Anesthesia, Nursing staff Bharat, Suresh, and a team of PICU staff Manish were supported in this successful operation which lasted for 5 hours. In this operation, a new genital was created from the baby's thigh muscles and was attached to the uterus. Pediatric surgeon Dr. Praveen Jhanwar explained that Vaginal atresia (Thampadans. Jatmap) is a congenital anomaly in which the genitalia are either closed or absent while the uterus is present. Both the above conditions are unknown to the parents and doctors until menstruation starts in adolescence. Dr. Jhanwar clarified that usually, the delay in menstruation is ignored, leading to late detection of the disease.

It has been six months since the operation on the baby, and she has regular periods and is leading an everyday life. During the hospitalization of the girl child, she also presented a beautiful poem as a thank you to the doctor and his team. The family thanked Chairman Rahul Agarwal, medical doctors, and all the staff.
