Meena. He said that the state government is in turmoil. Who will go between Ashok Gehlot and Sachin Pilot in the decision to be taken after the 19th is not known? If this government does not last, then elections are to be held in Rajasthan immediately after the Gujarat elections in March-April. The government which is not working for the people should be removed.

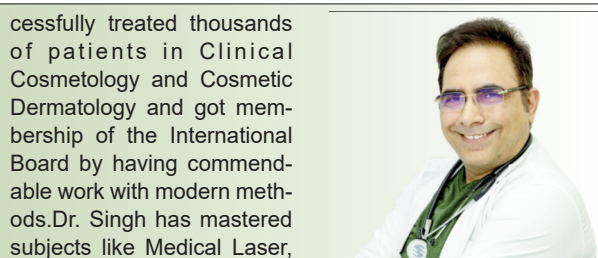
