

## Successful organization of Science, Maths and English Olympiad



**Udaipur:** International level competition Science, Maths and English Olympiad was successfully organized by Science Olympiad Foundation at Central Public Senior Secondary School, Udaipur city. In which apart from Udaipur city, about 680 students from Sirohi, Dungarpur and Banswara regions of Kshetra participated. These girl students got selected from the first level and appeared in the second level examination. This was the last level exam. 8 other centers in the state were Chittorgarh, Kota, Bhilwara, Ajmer, Jaipur, Jodhpur, Rajsamand and Bikaner. 32,000 girl students had participated in the first level. This international level competition is organized every year.

# Rajasthan budget and Udaipur

**C**hief Minister Ashok Gehlot presented the last budget before Friday's 2023 assembly elections in the Rajasthan Assembly. While some new announcements were made in this budget, the size and benefits of some old schemes were increased. Chief Minister Gehlot said that the general public would find this election budget before the elections, but this budget has been prepared to keep 2028 in mind.

The budget announcements made in the field of education included the establishment of a new college, the Mahatma Gandhi English Medium School, and the opening of arts, commerce, science, and agriculture faculties in a block-level higher secondary school.

The major announcement in the health field was to increase the insurance amount from Rs 10 lakh to Rs 25 lakh in the Chiranjeevi Health Insurance Scheme.

Apart from this, the budget also announced that electricity consumption of up to 100 units would be accessible. Along with this, LPG cylinders will be given for ₹ 500 to the

beneficiaries coming under BPL and Ujjwala schemes. What did Udaipur get?

■ The most significant gift for Udaipur was the announcement of the construction of the Dewas-3 and Dewas-4 dams. These dams will be constructed for Rs 1691 crore. This will ensure an additional supply of drinking water to Udaipur. This project will solve the drinking water problem in Udaipur, known as the city of lakes.

■ In the budget, it has been proposed to establish industrial areas in 50 subdivisions, including Lasadia, Kotda, Jhadol, Rishabhdev, Semari, Salumbar, and Sarada of Udaipur.

■ It has also been announced to set up Divyang Mahavidyalaya in Udaipur in the coming year. Science Park and Planetarium will be established in Udaipur to spread scientific thinking among the youth.

■ Electric trade will also be started in women ITI of Udaipur.

■ Elevated road will be constructed from the Bhuwana intersection to Bhuwana village in Udaipur for 90 crores.

■ Ahad river bridge connecting Sector 3 to Madrfi



Industrial Area in Udaipur will be made into four lanes.

■ Critical care blocks will be set up in 8 medical colleges and district hospitals, including Udaipur and Banswara.

■ Industrial areas in Udaipur's Sarada, Rishabhdev, Salumbar, Lasadia, Jhadol, Kotra and Semari, Banswara's Sajjagarh, Chittorgarh's Rawatbhata, Bhadesar, Dungarpur's Chikhli, Sawla, Rajsamand's Kumbhalgarh and Deogarh, Pratapgarh's Pipalkhant, Chhoti Sadri and Dharjayad will be established.

■ Air cargo will be set up in

Udaipur.

■ Announcement of 3D city project for Udaipur, Kota, Jodhpur, and Ajmer cities.

■ Golf Tourism: International-level golf courses will be developed at five prominent tourist places, including Udaipur, Mount Abu, and Jodhpur, at the cost of Rs 125 crore.

■ Neemuch Mata Temple in Udaipur and Jaldevi Sansara of Nathdwara, restoration work will be done in Gangeshwar Ji Matrikundiya Temple of Chittorgarh.

■ Panorama will be made

in Chavand, the Nirvana place of Maharana Pratap.

■ Additional Superintendent of Police office will open in Kherwara.

■ Municipality will be formed in Kherwara of Udaipur and Bhim of Rajsamand.

■ Jawar Anicut will be built on the Tidi river for Rs 200 crore to increase the water inflow in Dia Dam in the Udaipur district.

What did the Udaipur division get?

The most significant announcement in the budget for the Udaipur division can be

considered the establishment of medical colleges in the Pratapgarh and Rajsamand districts. With this, medical students of the state will get more opportunities. With the establishment of the new medical college, there will be an increase and improvement in the level of medical facilities in the division.

■ Apart from this, some announcements have also been made in the budget to promote sports, including opening a football academy in Banswara. Apart from this, there is a proposal in the budget to open an incubation and innovation center at Govind Guru University in Banswara.

■ An integrated Ayurveda, Yoga, and Naturopathy college will be opened at Nathdwara, Rajsamand.

■ Nursing college will open in Nimbahera.

■ To increase the water availability in the Rajsamand dam, capacity augmentation work of the Khari feeder will be done. Rs 80 crore will be spent on this.

Apart from this, Galiyakot of Dungarpur has the gift of a Girls' College.

### This budget will act as a booster dose - Rajpurohit

**Udaipur:** Rajasthan Pradesh Congress Social Media State Convener Dr. Sanjeev Rajpurohit in a press release that the Budget 2023-24 will act as a booster dose for the historical progress of Rajasthan.

Rajpurohit said that 76 lakh families of Ujjwala Yojana would get Rs.500. It is a historic step to make provision for giving LPG cylinders.

Along with this, the condition of increasing free electricity from 50 units to 100 units for domestic consumers in this budget will also be a relief step for middle-class families. The announcement of increasing insurance from 10 lacks to 25 lacks in the most popular Chiranjeevi Yojana across the country will prove to be a boon for low-income families. The 50% discount on roadways bus fare for half of the state's population (women) is welcome. Giving government jobs to orphaned children due to the global pandemic Corona shows the sensitivity of the Jananayak Chief Minister.

The provision of free electricity up to 2000 units per month for the farmers will bring relief to the food providers of the state. Overall, this budget of the Rajasthan government will act as a booster dose in the progress of Rajasthan.

The state government has presented the projects of the central government in its name, this is only an attempt to loot the applause, and due to the election year, the people of the state Have been shown only dreams of lies - Chittorgarh MP CP Joshi said the above while reacting to the election budget of the Rajasthan government.

Member of Parliament Joshi said that the budget announced by the state government of Rajasthan in the first and second year of its tenure had not been started, and what has been started has never materialized to date. Have seen

In every budget the state government presents, the state government has tried to present centrally promoted schemes in its name. Most of the projects presented in the MNREGA for the agriculture budget are part of the central government's schemes. Similarly, tourism culture, Swachh Bharat Mission, Clean Water Mission for Scheduled Caste-Scheduled Tribes and Water for every house, Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan, PM Shree Yojana, National Health Mission, Tribal Eklaya School, Rajivika, Old Age, Widow, Divyang Pension Scheme, for colleges Fund, Medical College, Rural Roads, MNREGA are also part of the scheme of Government of India.

Apart from this, there is nothing new in the special budget regarding the farmers. The Modi government at the Center has given the benefit of Kisan Samman Nidhi and Crop Insurance Scheme to the farmers directly in their account, whereas in this budget separate agriculture budget is claimed. There is nothing special in this.

### Exemption from TP ignored – Manoj Joshi



**Udaipur:** There was a long-standing demand for exemption from TP and portal registration fees on the issue of minor mineral powder manufactured by the mineral grinding

industry; due to non-announcement in the budget, entrepreneurs have been disappointed. Uninterrupted power supply to small and micro enterprises and subsidy for setting up captive solar power plants to industries was expected, but that has not been fulfilled. The proposal of Rs 400 crore for the infrastructure development of Rico's industrial area is welcome. Gudli, Sukher, and Maddi industrial regions were selected, but why Rico Kaldwas was deprived is beyond understanding.

### Disappointment in industries

**Udaipur:** President of Udaipur Marble Association, Pankaj Gangawat, said that industries had been disappointed with this budget.

Before the budget, the state government organized a pre-budget meeting with various industrial institutions through the Finance Department for divisional-level discussions on the upcoming budget.

Pankaj Kumar Gangawat prominently kept the matter of expansion of the industrial sector in this budget. Udaipur is the leading Center of the mineral industry in Rajasthan. Sukher-Amberi industrial area was established by Udaipur about 30 years ago for the marble industry. Still, for the last 30 years, the industrial land of the Sukher-Amberi industrial area has not been expanded by RIICO. With this budget, all the marble traders hoped that the industrial sector

would develop, but the pending demand of our marble traders for the last 25 years has also disappointed them.

In the last budget, the state government also announced opening industrial areas at each tehsil level. Still, no industrial area has yet been formed in the Badgaon tehsil area near Sukher industrial area in Udaipur, for which Udaipur Marble Association has been continuously demanding.

### Somewhere happy, somewhere sad, budget

**Udaipur:** Social worker and line producer Mukesh Madhwani said that the state government's budget is average. In some ways, the government has made good announcements, but it isn't very reassuring in the context of Udaipur. The residents of Udaipur had made various demands to the state government, which were not fulfilled.

Demands like film city, self-defense training center, and unique budget for tourism were included. However, the announcement of three dams for drinking water is good.

### There is no provision to reduce inflation



**Udaipur:** CA Dr. Nirmal Kunawat, former chairman of the Tax Bar Society, said that no provision was made to reduce inflation in the Rajasthan budget presented by Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot.

There was no reduction in the VAT tax rate on petrol and diesel. There was also no reduction in 30 percent surcharge in stamp duty. Dr. Kunawat said the provision of 1691 crores for the Dewas scheme is welcome, which will benefit the people of

Udaipur. On the other hand, Auditorium Convention Center, Cricket Academy, etc., are welcome steps for Udaipur. Reduction in roadways buses for 25 lakh women.

### There is no shortage of funds for the development of the area - Dr. Parmar

**Udaipur:** Former Higher Education Minister and current MLA Dr. Dayaram Parmar said there would be no shortage of funds for the development of the area.

### Budget speech became a joke - Arvind Sisodia

**Kota:** Arvind Sisodia, State Co-Convener of BJP Rajasthan State, Media Relations, has accused Congress Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot of destroying the secrecy, seriousness, and dignity of the budget. He said that Gehlot knows that now his state government is just a temporary guest; neither the public will repeat it nor the Congress party will make him the next chief ministerial face. There is no accountability, and the budget has been presented. Therefore, at least present something.

Media coordinator Sisodia said that it is clear from reading the paragraphs of the previous budget in the budget presentation that he has prepared and presented the budget amidst an unhealthy mindset. Because of this, Rajasthan Vidhansabha has to face embarrassment in the whole country.

### Schemes of the state showing in the budget of the Center - MP Joshi
