How will the government repeat due to the fight between the Gehlot-Pilot faction?

New Delhi: The news of former Deputy Chief Minister Sachin Pilot launching new political innings and making a big bang by announcing that he is leaving the Congress party finally got wind on Sunday. We had written in this column today that this will not happen, and Sachin Pilot Group is once again working on a strategy to create tremendous pressure on the Gehlot government just before the state assembly elections, and their fundamental objective is to organize state elections for the upcoming elections. The coordination committee has to be captured to occupy the chief minister's chair by getting maximum tickets to their supporting candidates.

In this background, on Sunday, Sachin Pilot took out the last arrow from his quiver and stood on the cusp of the

assembly elections, and Rajasthan, one of the only three Congress-ruled states in the country, once again put pressure on the Congress high command and the Gehlot government. Has taken out his last weapon of politics.

Sachin Pilot organized a reporter's conference in Jaipur on Sunday, raising the issue of corruption and collusion between Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and former BJP Chief Minister Vasundhara Raje, which has worked to bring more heat in the politics of both parties. He organized a one-day protest against his own party's government in Jaipur on April 11, the birthday of Jyoti Baan Phule, in protest against the alleged scams such as land, mines, and other alleged scams that took place during Vasundhara Raje's tenure. Has announced going on a

hunger strike. In this way, he has once again tried to put pressure on the party's high command and Chief Minister Gehlot. Apart from Pratap Singh Khachariawas, cabinet minister of the Gehlot government, no other prominent leader has supported the demands of the pilot. Pilot attended a Youth Congress rally in Jaipur on Saturday along with Khachariawas, and he put an end to speculations of leaving the party, but today instead, his intentions of pressure politics have come to the fore.

There is no doubt that Gehlot, Sachin, and other party leaders had made serious allegations of corruption against the then Chief Minister Vasundhara Raje's government before the last assembly elections and had staged dharnas, etc., several times.

By the way, it is not new to make such allegations by the opposition party during the election season. This time, the BJP is in this role and accuses the



Gehlot government, its ministers, and MLAs of being mired in corruption. Political experts say that if we look at the pol-

itics of Rajasthan so far, there has not been a tradition of vendetta politics since independence; otherwise, like the southern and other states,



many chief ministers and ministers in Rajasthan have been arrested and jailed. Congress Chief Minister Mohan Lal

Sukhadia ruled the state together for the most extended period, and his forty ministers were called by the leaders of the then opposition party,



Maharawal Laxman Singh and Bheron Singh Shekhawat, etc. Ali Baba and forty thieves and others Many allegations have

been leveled against the Chief Ministers, but when the Janata Party government came to power in 1977, no work was done by the new government with a sense of revenge. Although Gehlot, in his second Chief Minister's term, had set up a commission to investigate the allegations against the Vasundhara government, it failed. He was also not inspired by the politics of revenge. Ghanshyam Tiwari, a strong leader of RSS background of his own party, BJP, strongly opposed Vasundhara Raje's government house, left his party on this issue, and joined Congress, but the Gehlot government did not stop the facilities given to the former Chief Ministers and Governors in the state. Continued. This shows that political decorum and decency have always been above

petty politics in Rajasthan. Political experts say that Congress leader Rahul Gandhi and other opposition leaders are today accusing Narendra Modi of the center of taking action against the leaders of the opposition party with a sense of revenge if the Gehlot government in Rajasthan had also taken such action just before the elections. If so, what message will be sent to the voters?

Salim Durani had deep relations with Rajasthan & Gujarat

Famous in his times and hit sixes on demand of fans, all-rounder cricketer Salim Durani left for heavenly abode at an age of 88 on April 02.

Expressing deep condolences to this unique and great player Prime Minister Narendra Modi said that, "he had a great contribution in the emergence of Indian cricket across the globe. Salim Durani had a very old and strong association with Gujarat. He played for Saurashtra and Gujarat for a few years. He also made Gujarat his home.

Salim Durani had strong relations with Rajasthan. It was Rajsingh Dungarpur and Maharana Bhagwat Singh Udaipur inducted Salim Durani to play Ranji Trophy matches for Rajasthan and he brought victory to Rajasthan a number of times by playing rare

this he got up and said look if I don't take a wicket in the very next over, I will never play cricket in future. Saying this he went to the field, asked the captain of the team to let him bowl, quickly struck two wickets, captured a catch, came back in the gallery and set down back and said that I have done my job and that don't tell me that I didn't do anything.

In Jaipur he used to stay in the Rungta guest house of Purushottam and Kishan Rungta, administrators of the cricket to whom my elder brother Triloki Nath Sharma was Secretary to.

Raj Singh Dungarpur had strict instructions not to take care of food and Drinks of Salim Durani or else he will not be able to play the match next day, but despite that he used to have Food/Drinks of his choice by winning hearts of all with his vocal and



and memorable cricket. Sawai Mansingh and Chugan stadiums remained witness to his all round game.

Durani used to hit six in the direction from where a call was there. At many times he used to root out stumps of the opposite team just at an instance of his captain. He was known for his typical mood against any big or great cricketer. He didn't like the fielding much and often used to leave the ground saying to his captain that call me whenever there was a need.

I still vividly remember when he came into the VIP gallery and sat near my father Kanti Nath Bhatt, Secretary to Maharawal Lakshman Singh, former Speaker of the legislative assembly of Rajasthan during a match opposition team was not losing any wicket. My father Kanti Nath Bhatt said to Salim Durani in Gujarati that come on Salim Bhai, Rajasthan is struggling despite you being there. Listening to

Today we recall many such memories. Salim Durani used to play for Raj Singh Dungarpur and Maharana Bhagwat Singh, so only he also played a few exhibition matches on of MB College, Udaipur and Lakshman grounds, Dungarpur. He very much liked to stay at Shiv Nivas, Udaipur and Uda Vilas palace, Dungarpur. He played a lot of matches under captaincy of Raj Singh Dungarpur associated with Dungarpur royal family and the cricketer Hanumant Singh form Banswara royal family for Rajasthan in Ranji trophy matches. Famous for hitting sixes on call of public Salim Durani had exhibited this miracle during the decade of seventies at college ground of Banswara, but before doing so he got out by a local bowler Dilip Nagar. But he still continue to play and hit six on demand of fans of Banswara. According

to senior journalist Pradeep Dwivedi, his film 'Charitra' was seen in the Gokul Talkies.

Morning of April 02, Sunday didn't bring in good news for Indian cricket and its fans. Entire sports world was reeling under the news of the sad demise of the great cricketer Salim Durani. Durani breathed his last at a hospital in Jam Nagar, Gujarat. He was struggling with cancer.

Born in Afghanistan Salim Durani played for Indian cricket for many years. Durani was the first player to be honoured with coveted Arjun Award. He also received 'Khel Ratn' and many other prestigious awards.

Known as the best all rounder Durani had the capability to perturb the best batsmen of the world of the era. He played a vital role in the memorable victory of India over West Indies in Trinidad way back in the year 1970-71. Then he had turned the table in favour of India by getting out explosive batsman like Gerry Sobers and Clive Lyod.

Born in Kabul Salim Durani had foretold in his very childhood that he will become a cricketer.

Durani played his first test against Australia on January 01, 1960 at Brebourn Stadium, Mumbai. It was good debut match. Left handed batsman and spinner played cricket for India for almost 13 years. During this period he scored 1202 runs at an average of 25.04 coming out one century and seven half centuries from his bat. He was such a player who used to hit a six on the demand of fans. Besides this he also earned a great fame in bowling too. He claimed 75 wickets in hours International career. He was a left arm spinner. Salim Durani not only represented India, but also played Ranji matches for Rajasthan, Gujarat and Saurashtra. Salim played 170 matches and made 8685 runs and takes 484 wickets. He played last match at Brabourne Stadium, Mumbai against England on February 06, 1973.

Known for his attractive looks, he also worked for a Bollywood film Charitra in 1973 and acted with then renowned actress Parveen Bobby.

Today player and an actor Salim Durani is no more with us, but his memories will always be there with people, especially, among cricket lovers.

Including God of the cricket Sachin Tendulkar, Sunil Gavaskar, Indian captain Rohit Sharma, former captain Virat Kohli and cricketers all over the world wish Salim Durani too stay in heavens.
