Will Kamal Nath be able to become a crisis solver ?

New Delhi. On the instructions of Congress National President Mallikarjun Kharge and party leader Rahul Gandhi, to alleviate the tremendous boil in the politics of Rajasthan and Congress due to the recent fast of former Deputy Chief Minister of Rajasthan, Sachin Pilot.

Former Chief Minister Kamal Nath has been cast as a troubleshooter. It is said that the National General Secretary of Congress, Priyanka Gandhi Vadra was the first to become active in this matter.

We had indicated in this column on Thursday that the entry of a prominent leader will resolve and mediate the differences between Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and Sachin Pilot in Rajasthan, and Kamal Nath is being activated to mediate in this complex matter. Is. In 2019 too, Kamal Nath and other senior leaders of the party played an essential role in resolving the differences between the two leaders.

After promoting senior leader Kamal Nath, the

Congress High Command has instructed Sukhjinder Singh Randhawa, in charge of Rajasthan, to stop his cheetah's move. The statement given by Randhawa on Friday also confirms this.

Sources said that Rahul Gandhi and Kharge asked National Organization General Secretary KC Venugopal to meet Sachin Pilot and listen to his side before deciding on the Pilot episode.

It is being told that at the behest of Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge and party leader Rahul Gandhi, Kamal Nath has spoken to senior party leaders, including Sachin Pilot, in this matter for the last two days. Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot can also be called to New Delhi in the next few days.

Rahul Gandhi believes that a permanent solution to this crisis is necessary during the assembly elections in Karnataka. Karnataka is the home state of party president Kharge. After Karnataka, elections will also be held in

Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, and Chhattisgarh by the end of this year. After that, the Lok Sabha general elections will be held. This middle party also has to do the critical task of bringing all the opposition parties on one platform against the Modi government. Rahul Gandhi has called both Ashok Gehlot and Sachin Pilot assets of the party. They consider the role of both to be important in the upcoming elections. In such a situation, the sooner this matter is resolved, the more it will be in the party's interest so that Congress does not suffer further losses due to this episode.

According to Congress sources, because of the responsibility given by Rahul Gandhi, Kamal Nath started his work on Thursday itself and met Pilot and KC Venugopal, the general secretary in charge of the organization. According to sources, he has also met senior Haryana leader Bhupinder Singh Hooda.

It is learned that Pilot has told senior leaders that the



demand for Action against the Raje government in alleged corruption cases cannot be termed anti-party activity. He argued that the party had exposed allegations of corruption against the Vasundhara Raje-led BJP government in the 2018 elections and that the government should act.

The demand for disciplinary

Action had gained momentum. But in Rajasthan, due to the public welfare schemes of Ashok Gehlot being widespread across the country, amid an atmosphere being created in favor of the Congress party, Sachin Pilot's sitting on hunger strike despite the instructions of the high command angered most of the

senior leaders of the party and against Sachin. Randhawa even went so far as to say that Rajasthan would not be allowed to become Punjab.

Several marathon meetings of Congress leaders have been held in the last two days on the instructions of the High Command to resolve this dispute in Rajasthan. Venugopal and the party's state-in-charge in Rajasthan, Sukhjinder Singh Randhawa, also met party president Kharge and Rahul Gandhi separately. After that, Randhawa's strong statements also appeared in the media.

Following the instructions of Kharge and Rahul, Organization General Secretary Venugopal met senior party leader Kamal Nath and gave him a message to intervene in the matter. After this, a meeting of Venugopal and Sachin Pilot took place at Kamal Nath's residence. Before meeting Hooda, Kamal Nath also met Venugopal and

Randhawa separately.

Earlier, Congress in charge of Rajasthan Sukhjinder Randhawa held a meeting with party chief Kharge on Wednesday regarding the episode related to the fast of former Deputy Chief Minister Sachin Pilot. He had a meeting with the party leadership on Thursday as well. Randhawa also discussed the matter with former party president Rahul Gandhi. He met Kharge twice on Thursday. Sources say that the consultation may continue further on the issue related to the Pilot. Randhawa said on Wednesday that Pilot raised the problem correctly, but his method needed to be corrected. He also said in the context of several earlier developments related to the Rajasthan Pradesh Congress that Action should have been taken many times earlier, which did not happen. Still, now Action will be taken regarding indiscipline. Notably, Kishin Pilot observed a one-day fast in Jaipur on Tuesday, demand-

ing Action against the alleged corruption cases in the previous BJP government headed by Vasundhara Raje in Rajasthan.

Senior leader Kamal Nath is seen as a troubleshooter in the national capital Delhi to calm this political storm in the Rajasthan Congress. However, no concrete result has been found so far. Political experts say that the old enmity between the Gehlot-Pilot groups. Seeing this, it takes more work to solve it. This time Sachin Pilot is seen in a fighting mood, while Ashok Gehlot is behaving calmly and dignifiedly. Gehlot has elevated his stature in the party by standing like a rock with the Congress and the Gandhi family in every hour of crisis.

In such a situation, there is discussion in the political corridors of the capital that Kamal Nath failed to save his government in Madhya Pradesh and could not stop a young fellow like Jyotiadiya Scindia from joining the BJP due to differences. Took up details.

Ranjit Singh Bhinder wrote a letter to the Governor of Rajasthan Kalraj Mishra to properly operate the Mahatma Gandhi English medium schools opened by the Gehlot government to construct separate buildings and to ensure English medium education.

Bhinder alleged in the letter that many English medium schools were opened where children do not even know how to read Hindi properly. As a result, children are running away from school. If the government's thinking was in the interest of education, students, and guardians, then it could have done good to the people by opening new primary schools, recruiting new buildings and full-fledged English medium teachers, and opening two to four schools at the block level. The former MLA asked why the government is intent on the problems of the teachers and the department. Through the letter, Governor Kalraj Mishra has been requested to order the state government to either construct separate buildings to run these schools properly, to run them entirely by appointing English medium teachers, or else English education Stop this pretending.
