Paras Ranka Indore, graced


the ceremony with their pres-

Swimming continuously for an impressive 3 hours and 15 minutes, Jharna covered a remarkable distance of 8.3 kilometers without any breaks.

This outstanding achievement has not only brought immense pride to Udaipur and Rajasthan but has also shone a spotlight on India's talent on the global stage. Jharna's swim took place on a Sunday morning at 10 am, according to British Summertime.

What makes Jharna's accomplishment even more remarkable is the fact that she is a Type 1 diabetic who depends on insulin. To ensure her safety during the challenging swim, she wore a swim glucose monitoring device. Jharna revealed that she has been dedicatedly training for open-water swimming over the past three years, regularly honing her skills in oceans, rivers, and lakes throughout the year. Even in the harsh winters, she perseveres by swimming in cold water, displaying her unwavering determination and commitment.

This latest milestone has elevated Jharna's status as the first Indian woman representing India in the race category held in the United Kingdom.
