



# Morari Bapu's Unique Twelve Jyotirlinga Ram Katha

**New Delhi,** During the month of Sawan's extra month, a unique Ram Katha by Morari Bapu will take place, covering each of the twelve Jyotirlingas in the country over 18 days, with 12 days dedicated to the Katha itself. Accompanying this journey will be two trains named Kailash and Chitrakoot, carrying 1008 listeners, promoting spiritual tourism in the country. This journey will cover approximately 12,000 kilometres across eight states. Along with visiting the twelve Jyotirlingas, the participants will also have the opportunity to visit three other holy sites: Jagannath Puri, Rameshwaram (also a Jyotirlinga), and Dwarka. Additionally, the travellers will get a chance to visit Tirupati Balaji Temple during the journey.

**Morari Bapu**  
The first phase of the Katha Yatra will commence on July 22 at Kedarnath, situated at an altitude of approximately 12,000 feet. The train journey from Rishikesh will begin the



following day, July 23. Morari Bapu, known for spreading the teachings of truth, love, and compassion through the Ram Katha for the past six decades, will conclude this journey in his ancestral village of Talgajarda in Gujarat. The discourse by Morari Bapu in the general area

can be identified from a distance as they will be adorned with pictures of the twelve Jyotirlingas, three holy sites, Tirupati Balaji, and the ancestral village of Morari Bapu. Morari Bapu has expressed his perspective on the Jyotirlinga Ram Katha Yatra, stating, "Through this sacred journey, we aim to unite the diverse fabrics of India and enhance the collective understanding of Sanatan Dharma. ## NMC Grants Approval to AIMS for 150 MBBS Seats

**Udaipur:** The National Medical Commission (NMC) has granted recognition and approval to Ananta Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Center, Rajasmand, for 150 MBBS seats.

**Udaipur:** Dream big enough to take years to fulfil, just as Rotary envisioned for polio eradication: Shekhar Mehta, Rotary District 3056 Governor, inaugurated the installation ceremony of Dr Nirmal Kunawat as the District Governor. Mehta emphasized that every Rotary club and Rotarian should dream so big that it takes years to achieve. Just like Rotary did for polio eradication. If a dream is fulfilled within a year, it is not a big dream but a small one. You are on the right path if people laugh when you share your dreams.

As the keynote speaker at the ceremony organized by Rotary Club Elite at Spectrum Resort, Mehta stated that Rotary serves the country while keeping its interests in mind, as Rotary has become the medium to accomplish such work. Every year, the Nobel Prize for Medicine is given for health-related achievements, but until now, only smallpox has been eradicated. Polio is on the brink of eradication. The government did not envision polio eradication on the scale that Rotary did.



Mehta suggested that every Rotary district should establish a hospital. Rotary annually provides millions of rupees worth of medical equipment to healthcare organizations for the benefit of the public. Considering this, he proposed that every Rotary district should focus on underserved areas and establish multi-specialty hospitals to ensure people have access to all facilities. Maintain a positive mindset and positive behaviour in life.

Mehta set a goal for every Rotary district in the country, urging them to unite to educate 200 million illiterate adults. The central government and Rotary have set a target to make 50 million illiterate adults literate by 2027. Rotary will achieve this through its members. This year, Rotary will create 50 check dams and 50 water bodies in the country, for which global grants should be sought.

On this occasion, former District Governor Ratnesh Kashyap and Nirmal Singhvi administered the oath to other officials of Rotary District 3056, including District Secretary Deepak Sukhadia.

During this event, Rotary Club Elite President Vikas Shrimaali stated that the club has undertaken numerous service projects in the city over the past 17 years, which every club member takes pride in. This year, the club will undertake several service projects that will have a widespread impact on the public.
