## India's Cancer Burden: A Call for Urgent Action

India is grappling with a rising burden of cancer, and the mortality rate for this dreaded disease is also on the rise. According to recent data presented in the Lok Sabha, there were 14.61 lakh cases of cancer detected in 2022, which is 35,000 more than the previous year. Alarmingly, out of these cases, 8.08 lakh patients lost their lives, compared to 7.89 lakh in 2021. This concerning trend demands immediate attention and necessitates the implementation of better curative, palliative, and preventive measures, along with the strengthening of cancer care infrastructure.

Another distressing aspect is India's high mortality-to-incidence ratio for cancer, which ranks among the highest in the world. A study conducted by FICCI-EY in 2022 revealed even

more worrisome news: the actual incidence of cancer in the country could be two to three times higher than the official figures. This highlights the urgency for the

establishment of more specialized hospitals equipped with oncologists and state-of-the-art machinery. Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya warned in December last year that cancer prevalence in India is projected to increase by 12.8 per cent.

One of the core issues contributing to the problem is the lack of easy access to specialist hospitals for timely detection and affordable treatment of cancer. Many cancer victims, unable to afford quality care, face immense challenges. To address this, the government must expedite the development of the promised 19 state cancer institutes and 20 tertiary care centers. The existing public healthcare system is already overburdened, and treatment costs in private hospitals are exorbitant. Therefore, it is essential to prioritize campaigns that raise public awareness about cancer detection and prevention. Risk factors such as tobacco and alcohol consumption, obesity, malnutrition, a sedentary lifestyle, and the consumption of processed and packaged foods containing preservatives have been linked to cancer. Encouraging healthy habits is crucial to combat this disease effectively.

As India's cancer burden continues to grow, a comprehensive approach involving government intervention, improved healthcare facilities, and public awareness campaigns is vital to alleviate the suffering of cancer patients and reduce the disease's impact on society. Taking decisive action now can pave the way for a healthier and more resilient future.
