Election Commission Announces Assembly Election Schedule for Five States

Electoral Cycle Commences with Schedule Declaration for Five Indian States: High-Stakes Battle for BJP and Congress Assembly Election Schedule Unveiled

The Election Commission of India has unveiled the schedule for Assembly elections in five states, with elections set to take place in single or dual phases, marking a crucial electoral cycle.

Dates and Phases

Phase I: Mizoram and Chhattisgarh will go to the polls on November 7.



Phase II: Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh will see voting on November 17.

Single-phase: Rajasthan votes on November 23, followed by Telangana on November 30.

Counting: The vote counting for all states is scheduled for December 3, concluding the process by December 5.

Key Figures and Initiatives

Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar announced that 16.1 crore people are eligible to vote across 679 Assembly segments, with 60.2 lakh first-time voters. Special efforts have

ensured 100% voter enrollment among 12 vulnerable tribal groups. The Election Commission has also set up 940 checkpoints to curb illegal inducements and monitor cargo movement.

Electoral Significance

One-sixth of India's Assembly segments and voters are poised to exercise their franchise in this high-stakes election cycle. Both the BJP and Congress express confidence in their prospects.

Strategies and Focus

Congress: Aims to retain Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan and strengthen its position as a formidable opposition force ahead of the 2024 Lok Sabha elections.

BJP: Focused on retaining Madhya Pradesh, making gains in Rajasthan and Chhattisgarh, and outperforming its 2018

performance.

Real-time Monitoring and Technology

Cutting-edge technology will be employed for real-time updates on cash, drug seizures, and other inducements used to influence voters during these elections.

Election Pitches and Accusations

The Congress is expected to emphasize the caste census as a significant election pitch, which has triggered division with the BJP accusing the Congress of dividing people along caste lines.

In a high-stakes battle for power and influence, the upcoming Assembly elections in these five Indian states are set to shape the political landscape, with both the BJP and Congress vying for victory and a stronger foothold in the nation's political arena.

Former MLSU VC Prof. AmarikaSingh Cleared of Academic Qualification Allegations by Rajasthan Governor

There has been a recent development concerning Prof. AmarikaSingh, the former Vice-Chancellor of Mohanlal Sukhadia University in Udaipur, Rajasthan. Allegations regarding his educational qualifications were the subject of controversy, but Rajasthan Raj Bhavan (the Governor's Residence) has now officially cleared him of these allegations and recognized him as eligible for the professorship.

According to the official order, an investigation was carried out by the Deputy Commissioner of Udaipur, along with a committee led by Prof. Neelima Singh. This investigation confirmed that Prof. Amarika Singh had indeed received all the benefits associated with the professor's position from July 20, 2007, to January 31, 2020. It was also found that the allegations against him lacked substantial evidence, and he had more than ten years of experience as a professor.

Furthermore, it's worth noting that in a similar case involving Gurukul University in Rajasthan, Prof. Amarika Singh had previously been cleared of all allegations. This led to the cancellation of FIRs (First Information Reports) against him based on the findings of a judicial inquiry.

Prof. Amarika Singh expressed his satisfaction with the outcome, thanking everyone for their support. He acknowledged the challenges he faced during the controversy but maintained his patience and courage, believing that the truth would eventually prevail. He expressed his gratitude to well-wishers and supporters for their unwavering encouragement.



PM Modi Launches 7,000 Crore Rupees Worth of Development Projects in Chittorgarh

Chittorgarh: Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated and laid the foundation stones for a series of development projects worth approximately 7,000 crore rupees in Chittorgarh, Rajasthan. Among the projects, the Prime Minister dedicated the Mehsana - Bhatinda - Gurdaspur Gas Pipeline, a significant infrastructure undertaking with a cost of around 4,500 crore rupees. World Record : Largest Chapati Ever Made, Weighing 185 Kilograms, Created in Rajasthan

Kailash Soni, the President of the Rajasthan Jan Manch, has achieved a world record by creating the world's largest chapati (roti) weighing 185 kilograms at the Harisheva Udaseen Ashram in Bhilwara. This extraordinary effort was made to connect people with the rich heritage of Hindu culture. The event, held on Sunday, October 8th, witnessed the preparation of this gigantic roti under the guidance of Swami Hansaram Udaseen, the spiritual leader of the ashram.

To create this massive roti, a special stove was constructed using 2000 bricks coated with pure clay and fueled by 1000 kilograms of coal. The roti, approximately 70 meters in diameter, was cooked using a specially designed enormous pan measuring 16 feet by 12 feet and weighing 1000 kilograms.

The event saw the presence and blessings of various spiritual leaders, including Mahamandaleshwar Swami Hansaram Udaseen, Mahant Babu Giri Ji, Mahant Mohan Sharan Ji, and others.
