# INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON COMPUTATIONAL **INTELLIGENCE AND AUTONOMOUS SYSTEMS** (ICIAS 2025) @ SPSU



**Udaipur:** Sir Padampat Singhania University (SPSU), Udaipur, successfully organised the International Conference on Computational Intelligence and Autonomous Systems (ICIAS 2025) on October 9–10, 2025, bringing together eminent academicians, researchers, and industry professionals from across

The conference featured insightful keynote and plenary lectures by eminent experts including Prof. Raghvan K. (IIT Gandhinagar), Prof. Manish Vashishtha (MNIT Jaipur), Dr. Govind Kumawat (IIM Udaipur), Prof. Noor Zaman (Taylor's University. Malaysia), Dr. Bhuvanesh Unhelkar (University of South Florida, USA), and Dr. Sayani Sarkar (Bellarmine University, USA). Their deliberations on Sustainability, AI, autonomous systems, digital transformation, and cybersecurity inspired meaningful discussions among participants and encouraged interdisciplinary collaboration.
