Adani Green Energy Gallery Hits Million Visitors

London: The Energy Revolution: Adani Green Energy Gallery at the Science Museum, London, has welcomed over one million visitors since its launch in March 2024. This award-winning, free-to-visit gallery explores the transformation of global energy systems and the urgent need for decarbonization to combat climate change.

The gallery features historical artifacts, modern innovations, and interactive exhibits from around the world, including hydrogen projects in Orkney, terracotta air-cooling facades in India, and solar farms in Morocco. Over 10,000 students have visited as part of educational trips.

SagarAdani, Executive Director of Adani Green Energy, said the milestone reflects the gallery's ability to inspire curiosity and dialogue on sustainability, while Sir Ian Blatchford, Chief Executive of the Science Museum Group, praised the design and storytelling of the exhibits.

Designed by Anon Works, the gallery received the Retrofit and Reuse Award for sustainable installation, repurposing over 200 metal shelving units and using recyclable materials and energy-efficient LED lighting.

Structured into three sections — Future Planet, Future Energy, and Our Future — the gallery showcases climate science, low-carbon technologies, and children's energy solutions. At its heart is 'Only Breath,' a five-meter sculpture of reused glass, steel, and wood, symbolizing the fusion of nature and technology.

Open free to the public, the gallery continues to educate and inspire global audiences on building a susta
